Pursuant to the order of adjourment of the meeting of September 17, 1928, the Commissioners met this day and hour, with Hon. C. M. Chambers, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, and Wright present;

When Commissioner Bushick, offered a motion, seconded by Commissioner Wright, that a certain permit granted the Animal Foods Products Company on April 9th, 1928, be revoked, which motion was carried on roll call by the following vote to-wit; Ayes, Chambers, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright, whereupon the following ruling was ordered entered upon the minutes to-wit;

IN THE MATTER OF THE PROTEST AGAINST THE ANIMAL FOOD PRODUCTS COMPANY, ON ZARZAMORA STREET.

On this 18th day of September, A. D. 1928, in open session of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, after hearing the testimony of witnesses and the argument of counsel, the Commissioners are of the opinion that the protest filed herein is well taken.

It is therefore ordered by the Commissioners that the action of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio granting the Animal Food Products Company a permit to erect and conduct a reduction plant for the manufacturing and canning of animal foods, at Zarzamora Street and the Southern Pacific Railroad tract, Lot 20, New City Block 3699, be and the same is hereby rescinded.

The Animal Food Products Company are allowed ninety days within which to move their plant from this location, but objections must be abated at once.
