

AN ORDINANCE 2010-05-20-0442

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF GRANT APPLICATIONS TO ALAMO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE CONGREGATE SENIOR MEALS/NUTRITION PROGRAM, HOME DELIVERED MEAL SERVICES, AND ELDERLY TRANSPORTATION SERVICES TO MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS, IN THE AMOUNTS UP TO \$5,856,000.00, \$1,135,350.00, AND \$855,000.00, RESPECTIVELY, FOR THE PROVISION OF SENIOR SERVICES FROM FY 2011 THROUGH FY 2013.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio Department of Community Initiatives provides congregate and homebound meals and transportation services to seniors living in San Antonio and Bexar County; and

WHEREAS, these programs are funded with General Funds and federal funds from the U.S. Departments of Health and Human Services and Agriculture awarded in grants by the Texas Department on Aging and Disability Services (DADS) through the Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG) ; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Congregate Senior Meals/Nutrition program is to provide seniors with a meal and nutrition services in a congregate setting at the 82 senior centers around the City of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, homebound meals are also provided for participating seniors that do not have the skills and abilities to safely be outside their homes and cannot participate in the meals served at the senior centers; and

WHEREAS, today, the Congregate Senior Meals/Nutrition program is the largest senior nutrition congregate meal program in the State and provides up to 3,800 meals daily Monday through Friday; and

WHEREAS, the Elderly Transportation Services program provides essential door-to-door, para-transit services to seniors, age 60 years and older, throughout Bexar County; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives or her designee is hereby authorized to submit grant applications to Alamo Area Council of Government for the Comprehensive Nutrition Project, Home Delivered Meal Services, and Supportive Services for the Elderly Project, in the amounts up to \$5,856,000.00, \$1,135,350.00, and \$855,000.00, respectively, for the provision of senior services from FY 2011 through FY 2013. A copy of said application is on file with the Department of Community Initiatives. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives, or his designee, is

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authorized to execute any documents necessary in connection with the submission of application documents. Acceptance and appropriation of funds will be addressed in subsequent ordinances upon award.

SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer (CFO), City of San Antonio. The CFO may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.







Submission of Grant Applications for Senior Programs

May 20, 2010

Purpose

- This Ordinance authorizes submission of grant applications to Alamo Area Council of Government for provision of senior services from FY 2011 through FY 2013
 - Congregate Senior Meals/Nutrition program
 - Home Delivered Meal Services
 - Elderly Transportation Services to medical appointments



Background

- City of San Antonio (COSA) Department of Community Initiatives (DCI) provides seniors living in San Antonio and Bexar County:
 - Congregate and homebound meals
 - Transportation services
- Programs funded by General Funds and federal funds from the U.S. Departments of Health and Human Services and Agriculture
 - Federal funds awarded in grants by Texas Department on Aging and Disability Services (DADS) through Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG)



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Request for Proposals

- Request for Proposal (RFP) released April 28, 2010
- RFP requires all interested parties to submit grant applications by June 3, 2010
- DCI recommends authorization to apply for funds to support:
 - Congregate Meals program
 - Home Delivered Meal Services
 - Senior Transportation Services



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Funding Request

Grant	Amount
Congregate Meals	\$ 5,856,000
Home Delivered Meal Service	\$ 1,135,350
Elderly Transportation Services	\$ 855,000
Total Requested	\$ 7,846,350

- If awarded, grant funds will be distributed over a three-year grant period from FY 2011 through FY 2013
- A ten percent cash match for all three grants is required
