AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$200.00 to pay Expenses of S. F. Crecelius, to Denver, Colo.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$200.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Flood Prevention Fund (San Antonio River) to cover expenses of S. F. Crecelus, Flood Engineer, to Denver, Colorado and return, for the purpose of inspecting gates to be used at the Olmos Dam.

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING AN ORDINANCE AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, LICENSING AND REGULATING AUTOMOBILES FOR HIRE, AS ORIGINALLY PASSED AND APPROVED ON THE 23RD DAY OF SEPTEMBER, A. D. 1915.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That Section Three of an Ordinance licensing and regulating automobiles for hire, passed and approved on the 23rd day of September, A. D. 1915, as amended May 31, 1918 and July 8, 1918, be and the same is hereby amended so that said Section Three thereof shall hereafter read as follows:-

2. "SECTION THREE: LICENSE FEE. For each automobile for hire, as defined in Section One of this ordinance, owned, controlled or operated within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, there shall be paid to the Commissioner of Taxation for use of the City an annual license fee of Twelve and 50/100 (\$12.50) Dollars. The amounts received by the City as such license fees shall be deposited and kept in the "Street Maintenance Fund", and all costs of traffic supervision and other expenses incident to said regulation, license and inspection shall be paid by the City out of the General fund; PROVIDED, that in the event of any person having an automobile not employed or used as an automobile for hire as herein defined at the beginning of any fiscal year and shall during such fiscal year desire a license for such vehicle as an auto for hire, then such license shall issue for the remaining part of such fiscal year and the license fee therefor shall be prorated and paid only for the unexpired portion of such fiscal year; but such license fee shall not in any case be less than one-half of the license fee for the full fiscal year."

3. A public necessity exists for the immediate operation of this Ordinance, and this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE BY THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, IN THE COUNTY OF BEXAR, STATE OF TEXAS, OF SEVEN MILLION DOLLARS (\$7,000,000) OF BONDS TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACQUISITION, IMPROVING AND EXTENSION OF THE WATER PLANT TO BE PURCHASED FROM NATT T. WAGNER OF ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF SAID BONDS AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST THEREOF; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MORTGAGE OR DEED OF TRUST UPON SAID WATER-WORKS PLANT AND SYSTEM TO ACQUIRED BY THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO; AND GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO THE PURCHASER OR PURCHASERS OF SAID PROPERTY AT A FORECLOSURE SALE MADE IN PURSUANCE OF SAID MORTGAGE OR DEED OF TRUST.
