The Special Meeting was called to order at 4:21 P.M. by the presiding officer, Mayor Pro Tem Yolanda Vera, with the following members present: BERRIOZABAL, WEBB, DUTMER, WING, MARTINEZ, VERA, WOLFF, LABATT, HASSLOCHER, CISNEROS. Absent: THOMPSON.

88-04 The Clerk read the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE 66,450

AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,445.00 IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE FUNDS, PROVIDING \$53,519.00 IN MATCHING FUNDS AND APPROPRIATING \$5,084.00 OUT OF SURPLUS REGIONAL TRAINING FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE OFFICE OF MUNICIPAL INTEGRITY.

Mr. Wing made a motion to approve the proposed Ordinance. Mr. Labatt seconded the motion.

Mr. Wing spoke in favor of the Ordinance and stated that the grant application would help support this office.

Mr. William Donahue, Assistant City Manager, stated that Detective Clancy's salary is presently being paid out of the Police Department's budget. He spoke of the sources of grant monies.

(At this point, Mayor Cisneros returned to the meeting but did not take the chair.)

The motion, carrying with it the passage of the Ordinance, prevailed by the following vote: AYES: Webb, Wing, Martinez, Vera, Wolff, Labatt, Hasslocher, Cisneros; NAYS: Berriozabal, Dutmer; ABSENT: Thompson.

There being no further business at this Special Meeting to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 4:28 P.M. to convene a "B" Session.
