

AN ORDINANCE **2008-02-14-0106**

ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF VARIOUS COMPANIES TO PROVIDE THE CITY WITH VARIOUS TYPES OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES ON AN ANNUAL CONTRACT BASIS FOR FY 2007-2008 FOR A COMBINED ESTIMATED COST OF \$234,000.00, INCLUDING: (A) CLEANING AND SANITATION OF EMERGENCY VEHICLE INTERIOR; (B) ILLUMINATED STREET SIGNS; AND (C) LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE FOR DOWNTOWN OPERATIONS' PARKS AND MEDIANS.

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WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, this group of contracts represents a portion of approximately two hundred and fifty (250) annual contracts that will be brought before City Council throughout the remainder of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, these bids are from various companies to furnish the City with: cleaning and sanitation of emergency vehicle interior; illuminated street signs; and landscape maintenance for Downtown Operations' parks and medians; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves 2 low bid contracts, and 1 contract in which award was recommended to other than the low bidder because the low bidder failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the 2007-2008 budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bids of various companies to furnish the City with: cleaning and sanitation of emergency vehicle interior; illuminated street signs; and landscape maintenance for Downtown Operations' parks and medians are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit I. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing & Contract Services Department.


SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the low bid from Zama Real Estate Investment Group for landscape maintenance for Down Town Operations' parks and medians, failed to meet the City's specifications.

SECTION 3. The amounts will be encumbered upon issuance of various purchase orders, and payment is authorized to various vendors. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY 2007-2008 budget approved by City Council. The combined estimated total for contracts listed on this ordinance is approximately \$234,000.00.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific cost centers and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect February 24, 2008.


