

AN ORDINANCE 2011-08-04-0609

ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) FOR A SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP) IMPAIRED DRIVING MOBILIZATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000.00; AUTHORIZING AN IN-KIND MATCH OF \$10,595.00; AND ESTABLISHING A BUDGET FOR THE GRANT PERIOD AUGUST 19, 2011, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 5, 2011.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has offered a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Impaired Driving Mobilization Grant in the amount of \$30,000.00 to be used for overtime costs for DWI enforcement during the Labor Day holiday from August 19, 2011, through September 5, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is August 19, 2011, through September 5, 2011; and

WHEREAS, an in-kind matching contribution of \$10,595.00 is required for said grant; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designated representative are hereby authorized to accept a STEP Impaired Driving Mobilization Grant in the amount of \$30,000.00 from the TxDOT for the grant period August 19, 2011, through September 5, 2011, to be used for overtime costs needed for DWI enforcement during the Labor Day holiday. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

SECTION 2. Fund 26059000 (TxDOT) is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant. Should funding be awarded, the sum of up to \$30,000.00 from TxDOT and the required in-kind match of \$10,595.00 will be appropriated in said fund.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer (CFO), City of San Antonio. The CFO may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific cost centers, WBS

elements, internal orders, general ledger accounts, and fund numbers, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.


