

AN ORDINANCE 2008-08-07-0657

ACCEPTING \$19,000.00, AS REIMBURSEMENT, FROM SAN ANTONIO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT AND \$60,000.00 FROM NORTHSIDE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF MAST ARM MOUNTED SOLAR POWERED SCHOOL ZONE FLASHING BEACON ASSEMBLIES ON PRESA RD. (SPUR 122) FOR THE NEW MISSION ACADEMY SCHOOL, ON ELLISON ROAD FOR THE NEW VALE MIDDLE SCHOOL, ON BABCOCK ROAD FOR THE NEW CARNAHAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND ON KYLE SEALE FOR THE NEW BRANDIES HIGH SCHOOL LOCATED IN DISTRICTS 3, 6, AND 8.

**WHEREAS**, an interlocal agreement with multiple school districts within San Antonio setting forth Real Property Development Procedures, Fees, Responsibilities and Related Matters applicable to the districts was authorized by Ordinance No. 99156 on May 6, 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance will accept reimbursement from San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD) and Northside Independent School District (NISD) for expenses incurred for the construction and installation of mast arm mounted solar powered school zone flashing beacon assemblies for the following four (4) locations:

1. Presa Road (Spur 122) for the new Mission Academy School located in District 3 for SAISD,
  2. Ellison Road for the new Vale Middle School located in District 6 for NISD,
  3. Babcock Road for the new Carnahan Elementary School located in District 8 for NISD,
  4. Kyle Seale Parkway for the new Brandies High School located in District 8 for NISD;
- and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost for the installation of these traffic signals is \$79,000.00, of which City will receive reimbursement in the amount of \$19,000.00 from the San Antonio Independent School District and \$60,000.00 from the Northside Independent School District; and

**WHEREAS**, approval of this Ordinance is in compliance with the executed Interlocal Agreement set forth in Ordinance 99156 and is also consistent with City Council policy to leverage other funds; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is authorized to accept \$19,000.00 from the San Antonio Independent School District and \$60,000.00 from the Northside Independent School District for the construction and installation of mast arm mounted solar powered school zone flashing beacon assemblies.

**SECTION 2.** Funds generated by this Ordinance will be deposited into Fund 11001000 General Fund, Internal Order 223000000158 Traffic Recovery of Expenditures, General Ledger 6301120 Recovery of Current Year Expenditures.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day after passage.

**SUBJECT:**

Acceptance of Funds from SAISD & NISD

**SUMMARY:**

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager or her designee to accept reimbursement from San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD) and Northside Independent School District (NISD) for expenses incurred for the construction and installation of mast arm mounted solar powered school zone flashing beacon assemblies for the following locations:

1. On Presa Road (Spur 122) for the new Mission Academy School located in District 3 for SAISD;
2. On Ellison Road for the new Vale Middle School located in District 6 for NISD;
3. On Babcock Road for the new Carnahan Elementary School located in District 8 for NISD; and
4. On Kyle Seale Parkway for the new Brandies High School located in District 8 for NISD.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Ordinance 99156, passed and approved May 6, 2004, established an interlocal agreement with multiple school districts within San Antonio setting forth Real Property Development Procedures, Fees, Responsibilities and Related Matters applicable to the districts.

Section 6.01.d.i states *“Whenever a new school is to be located and constructed on, adjacent to, or abutting an existing arterial street or highway, as defined by the City Major Thoroughfare Plan, the DISTRICT will be required to fund, at its expense, any traffic signals or school zone/pedestrian crossing warning flashers and traffic control devices that are determined necessary by mutual agreement between CITY and District by virtue of the increased vehicular and pedestrian traffic anticipated to be generated by or from such school.”*

In an effort to reduce costs, the SAISD and the NISD have requested the City of San Antonio to construct and install the mast arm mounted solar powered school zone flashing beacon assemblies at four (4) locations. The total project cost is \$79,000.00.

**ISSUE:**

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept reimbursement in connection with the construction and installation of mast arm mounted solar powered school zone flashing beacon assemblies from the SAISD in the amount of \$19,000.00 and from the NISD in the amount of \$60,000.00.

Approval of this ordinance is in compliance with the executed interlocal agreement set forth in Ordinance 99156 and is also consistent with City Council policy to leverage private funds.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

City Council could choose not to accept the contribution from SAISD and NISD. However, this would result in the City funding the entire \$79,000.00 cost of this project.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The City will receive funds in the amount of \$19,000.00 from the SAISD and \$60,000.00 from the NISD.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval to accept reimbursement in the amount of \$79,000.00 from SAISD and NISD for the school zone flashing beacon assemblies.
