CANVASS OF REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Members of City Council present, assisted by City staff, then performed the official canvass of the votes from the May 1, 1993 City Council election, after which City Clerk Norma S. Rodriguez noted for the record that there were no changes to the unofficial election returns. She then directed that copies of those returns be made available to all City Council members and all other candidates present in the audience. Additional copies will be made available in the Office of the City Clerk.

City Clerk Norma S. Rodriguez then read the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE 77,860

DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD THE 1ST DAY OF MAY, 1993.

* * * *

WHEREAS, the regular municipal election was held on the 1st day of May 1993, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio for the ensuing term of office of two years; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates were submitted, the election was held and conducted and the returns thereof were made, all as required by the City Charter and the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council met on May 4, 1993, to canvass the returns of the said election; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council having convened May 4, 1993, to canvass the returns of the regular City election held May 1, 1993, after canvassing the returns of said election, does hereby find and declare the result of the election to be as follows:

SECTION 2. It is further declared that as a result of said election, the following persons were elected Council Members for two-year term commencing June 1, 1993:

Henry Avila, Member of Council, Place No. 4
Juan F. Solis, Member of Council, Place No. 5
Helen Ayala, Member of Council, Place No. 6
Bill Thornton, Member of Council, Place No. 8
Howard W. Peak, Member of Council, Place No. 9
Lyle T. Larson, Member of Council, Place No. 10

Nelson W. Wolff, Member of Council, Place No. 11, MAYOR

and each of them was elected by receiving a majority of all the votes cast for the office for which each was a candidate cast by the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio voting at said election, and they and each of them are hereby declared to be the lawful, and duly elected Council Member of the City for the places specified.

SECTION 3. It is further declared that as a result of said election, no candidate for Place No. 7, received a majority of all the votes cast by the qualified voters of the City voting in said election, therefore, no candidate was elected at said election for the office of Member of Council for Place 7, but that a second or run-off election will be necessary in order that received a majority of all the votes cast for the office. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for such place in the election shall again be voted for at the second or run-off election, to be called by separate ordinance:

Ramiro Cavazos

Ms. Billa Burke made a motion to approve the proposed Ordinance. Mr. Solis seconded the motion.

After consideration, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Ordinance, prevailed by the following vote: AYES: Perez, Pierce, Billa Burke, Nieto, Solis, Ayala, Labatt, Larson, Wolff; NAYS: None; ABSENT: Vera, Thornton.

In response to a question by Mayor Wolff, Ms. Rodriguez noted that Gov. Richards has not yet called the official runoff date for the U.S. Senate position vacated by Sen. Lloyd Bentsen; therefore, the runoff date for selection of the new District 7 City Council member also has not been set, inasmuch as plans call for holding the two elections simultaneously.

Ms. Rodriguez then distributed the Statement of Elected Officer forms to each successful City Council candidate present, said form to be signed and returned to the City Clerk for transmittal to the Secretary of State's office in Austin for official filing. She noted that the formal Oath of Office cannot be administered to newly-elected or re-elected members of City Council prior to that filing.


Ms. Rodriguez then administered the required oath involved in the Statement of Elected Officer.

She noted that informal swearing-in activities must be conducted within 10 days of the May 1, 1993 election date, and that a formal swearing-in ceremony is being planned for June 10, 1993.

Mayor Wolff then distributed to the appropriate re-elected or newly-elected City Council members their Certificate of Election.
