

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH TEXAS ENGINEERING EXTENSION SERVICE TO ALLOW QUALIFIED CITY EMPLOYEES TO BE MEMBERS OF TEXAS TASK FORCE ONE IN ORDER TO ASSIST THE STATE OF TEXAS AND THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, Texas Task Force One (TXTF-1) was organized by the Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) of the Texas A&M University System to assist the state of Texas and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) by deploying local resources in response to a regional or national disaster; and

WHEREAS, currently, twenty San Antonio Fire Department personnel are members of TXTF-1; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into an agreement with the TTEEX to allow qualified city employees to be members of TXTX-1; **NOW THEREFORE**:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the TEEX to allow qualified city employees to be members of TXTF-1 in order to assist the state of Texas and the federal government in urban search and rescue activities. A copy of the agreement is attached hereto, and the terms of the agreement are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
