

AN ORDINANCE

2008-11-06-0988

AMENDING ORDINANCE 2008-01-10-0016, WHICH AUTHORIZES THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS UPON AWARD FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES, TO CREATE A GRANT-FUNDED POSITION AND APPROVE A PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance amends Ordinance Number 2008-01-10-0016, dated January 10, 2008, creating a grant-funded position and approving a personnel complement in connection with a U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Grant; and

WHEREAS, the COPS Technology grant is the first of several financial sources for the Regional Emergency Communications, Information Sharing, and Mobile Data System Project; and

WHEREAS, in March 2008, SAPD staff met with the City's Chief Information Officer and the Assistant Finance Director, both of whom strongly recommended this position be upgraded to a Senior Management Analyst due to the high visibility of this project; and

WHEREAS, in April, SAPD requested approval from the U.S. Department of Justice, COPS Office to upgrade the position from a Management Analyst to a Senior Management Analyst which was approved in September by the COPS Office;

WHEREAS, in order for Human Resources to upgrade the position, it must be documented and authorized by Ordinance; **NOW THEREFORE:**


BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to amend Ordinance 2008-01-10-0016, dated January 10, 2008, creating a grant-funded position and approving a personnel complement in connection with a U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services Grant. The City Manager, or her designee, is further authorized to execute any and all documentation necessary to effect said amendment.

SECTION 2. The grant funded position will have no impact on the City's General Fund. Funds were previously allocated in the grant by Ordinance No. 2007-06-28-0793.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, provided that it is passed by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, this ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
