

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, JULY 27TH, A.D.1922, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Rieden, Wright. Absent, Pfeiffer.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation:
M.M.Kimbrow, for refund of taxes.
E.J.Gruenwald, for refund of taxes.

Petition of Westm Beauty Sanctuary for use of San Pedro Springs, Sept. 8 & 9, 1922. was read and referred to Commissioner of Parks, etc.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire & Police:
D.Heye, to erect roof sign Market & S.Presa Street.
Citizens, requesting 6" water mains on Theo Avenue.

Communication of E.B.Alling, protesting against the paving on N.Pine Street was read and referred to City Engineer.

Commissioner Lambert introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Black, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

No. 145

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating money to pay for band concert.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400) be hereby appropriated to defray the expenses of the band concerts held in Brackenridge Park from July 16 to 22 inc. To be charged to Zoo Fund.

Commissioner Lambert recommended that the petition of Zay Smith, et al for the privilege of placing sanitary garbage cans in parks be not granted. Action was deferred on the matter until a future meeting, at the request of Mr. Smith.

Commissioner Wright recommended that petition of A.Guimarda for permit to install gasoline tank and pump cor. Garden and Pereira Sts. be granted. Adopted.

Commissioner Rieden introduced the following ordinances, which were read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes Black, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$4000 to pay Paul Hansen.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$4000 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund (St. Com. Dept.) to pay Paul Hansen for constructing West End Lake Levee.

No. 146

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$775.00 to pay S.A.Sewer Pipe Co.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$775.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund to pay S.A.Sewer Pipe Co. as per itemized invoice now on file. Sewer Construction \$775.00

Petition of citizens requesting the name of Short Street be changed to W.Mistletoe Avenue was read the second time and laid over.

A committee of citizens residing in the neighborhood of East Crockett Street addressed the Commissioners protesting against the establishment of a colored hospital in that locality. The matter was referred to the Board of Health for investigation.

A petition of W.M.Morgan to cut the curbing on Flores Street to install gasoline pump was rejected by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Black, Nays, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Bid to supply the Fire Department with lathe was rejected on recommendation of the Purchasing Agent.

Bids for forage were held up, and the Purchasing Agent instructed to try and procure a greater number of bids.

A bid for cypress lumber was opened and referred to City Purchasing Agent.

The following ordinances were read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Black, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

No. 148

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating the sum of \$100. or so much thereof as may be necessary to purchase parts from Clifton George Motor Company to repair Dr. Conn L.Milburns automobile.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$100 or so much thereof as may be necessary be and is hereby appropriated out of the Fire Department 1922 General Fund to purchase automobile parts from Clifton George Motor Company to repair Dr. Conn L.Milburns automobile, which was damaged in collision with a truck belonging to the Fire Department of the City of San Antonio.

The above mentioned automobile was standing at the curb on Houston Street and the department in making a run collided with the said Milburns automobile, and the said Dr. Conn L. Milburn has agreed and does agree to accept the replacement of all broken parts as full and final settlement of all damages herein incurred.

Be it further ordered that the Purchasing Agent be and is directed to issue an order

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to Clifton George Motor Company for the above mentioned parts with which to repair said Dr. Conn L. Milburns Automobile.

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No. 149

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$32.70 to reimburse Incidental Expense Fund of the City Clerk.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,
1st. That the sum of \$7.45 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund (Clinic Dept.) to reimburse Incidental Expense Account of City Clerk for expressage and supplies paid for.

2nd. That the sum of \$25.25 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund to reimburse Incidental Expense Account of City Clerk for sundry items paid, all as per receipted bills to be filed with the City Auditor.

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No. 150

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$10. to pay Pauline Arosco account fine remitted.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$10.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund to pay Pauline Arosco account of fine remitted by order of the Mayor. This fine should not have been collected as case was appealed and fine assessed in County Court.

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AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the release of special assessment lien on lot one New City Block No. 790, in the name of Austin North.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to execute a release of assignable certificate No. 10 for street improvements on Main Avenue and Romana Street, and to release the lien filed against the same by ordinance passed and approved Nov. 4, 1920 and recorded in Bexar County deed records in Vol 612 pages 422 to 425. And that the Mayor be authorized to accept \$1000 in full payment of same.

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of San Antonio to enter into a contract for and on behalf of the City of San Antonio with the San Antonio Metal Sign Company., was read and laid over until Thursday, August 3, 1922.

The following resolution was read and adopted:

RESOLUTION

Directing the City Engineer of the City of San Antonio to construct a grade crossing over and across the tracks of the San Antonio Belt and Terminal Railway Company, and the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railway Company of Texas, over and along Guadalupe Street, San Antonio, Texas.

WHEREAS, by an ordinance passed and approved on the 1st day May, 1922, the San Antonio Belt and Terminal Railway Company and the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railway Company of Texas, and C.E. Schaff, receiver of said railway companies, were notified and directed to construct a grade crossing over and across the tracks of the San Antonio Belt and Terminal Railway Company, on Guadalupe Street, and

WHEREAS, said railway companies and each of them have failed to comply with said notice and requirements, and have failed to construct the crossing over the said tracks of said railway companies on Guadalupe Street,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the City Engineer of the City of San Antonio be and he is hereby directed to proceed to construct a grade crossing over and across the tracks of said railway companies on Guadalupe Street, San Antonio, Texas, in conformity with the ordinance passed and approved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, on the 1st day of May, 1922, as aforesaid.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
