

AN ORDINANCE 2011-09-08-0744

**AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF LINE OF DUTY
LEAVE FOR FIRE APPARATUS OPERATOR DERECK
HILLYER.**

* * * * *

WHEREAS, section 143.073 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a firefighter injured in the line of duty is entitled to line-of-duty injury leave with full pay for a period commensurate with the injury and not to exceed one year; and

WHEREAS, section 143.073 also provides that a municipality's governing body may extend the line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year; and

WHEREAS, San Antonio Fire Department Fire Apparatus Operator (FAO) Dereck Hillyer was injured in the line of duty on August 15, 2009, and, as a result, required leave in excess of one year to address said injury; and

WHEREAS, FAO Hillyer is requesting an extension of line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year for the period August 15, 2010, to November 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, approving the requested extension will restore 864 hours (36 shifts) of personal leave to FAO Hillyer; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. An extension beyond one year of San Antonio Fire Department Fire Apparatus Operator Dereck Hillyer's line-of-duty injury leave for the period August 15, 2010, to November 30, 2010, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Potential funding sources for this ordinance include, but are not limited to, cost savings within the fund centers, adjustments to the year-end accrual for leave payable, and the closing ordinance. All expenditures shall be in accordance with the current fiscal year budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer (CFO), City of San Antonio. The CFO may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific cost centers, WBS

elements, internal orders, general ledger accounts, and fund numbers, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, provided that it is passed by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, this ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.






