AN ORDINANCE *MD-136*

Appropriating the sum of \$120.00 to pay C.Raeber for services rendered in drawing plans for Incinerator Plant.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of One Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$120.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund, charged to the Incinerator Fund to pay C.Raeber for services rendered in drawing plans for Incinerator Plant.

AN ORDINANCE *-137*

Authorizing the release of lien on lots five (5), six (6), eight (8), Nine (9), thirteen (13) to twenty (20), C.B.2211, made through error.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WHEREAS, the City through its Board of Health caused a lien to be ~~lifted~~ filed against lots 5, 6, 8, 9, 13 to 20, City Block 2211, on July 13, 1918, for cutting weeds off said lots, said lots having been described as the property of J.P.Ward; and

WHEREAS, J.P.Ward does not and did not at the time own said lots, nor were weeds cut from these lots or any of them, but that same is an error on the part of the department;

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that this is to authorize the release of said lien so erroneously filed in Vol. 542, page 237, Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas, and to direct the execution of the necessary release.

AN ORDINANCE *-138*

Authorizing the release of lien on lots four (4), Five (5), and Six (6), City Block 372, in the name of R.T.Pruitt filed through mistake.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, through its Board of Health caused a lien to be filed against lots 4, 5, and six in City Block 2296 on the North side of East Courtland Place on the 31st day of July, 1919, for cutting weeds off said lots, said lots having been described as the property of R.T.Pruitt; and

WHEREAS, there was no notice served upon R.T.Pruitt the owner of said lots that said work would be done, if not done by himself, and by reason of the said fact the lien filed upon said lots is not a lawful lien:

THEREFORE, be it ordained that this to authorize the release of said lien so erroneously filed and recorded in Vol. 541, on pages 214 and 215 of the Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas, and to direct the execution of the proper release therefor.
