

AN ORDINANCE 2007-02-15-0165

APPROVING A TOTAL ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION AMOUNT OF \$783,821.52 AND AWARDING AN INDEFINITE DELIVERY CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$783,821.52 TO SAECO ELECTRIC AND UTILITY FOR AS-NEEDED CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL EQUIPMENT, SIGNS, PAVEMENT MARKINGS, CURB RAMPS, VEHICLE DETECTION DEVICES, AND OTHER WORK, IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY-WIDE TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION PROJECT, FROM THE FY 06-07 ANNUAL TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADE PROGRAM AND DISTRICT 4 HUD SECTION 108 DISTRICT-WIDE ACCESS AND MOBILITY FUNDS

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted in connection with the City-Wide Traffic Signal Installation Project; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by **SAECO Electric and Utility** in the amount of \$783,821.52; and

WHEREAS, this Project includes but is not limited to the installation of traffic signal equipment, signs, pavement markings, curb ramps, vehicle detection devices, and any other work required for the completion of up to twelve (12) traffic signal systems located throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department will purchase and furnish the hardware for the twelve (12) traffic signal systems and provide them to the contractor for each of the specific locations; and

WHEREAS, five (5) locations were identified in the solicitation for immediate installation under the contract and the capacity for seven (7) additional locations was made available should the contract term allow for the installation of any additional locations; the five locations requiring immediate installation are as follows:

1. Babcock Road at Spring Rain
2. Ellison Drive at Military Drive West
3. Hausman Road at University Heights
4. Metro Parkway at Wetmore Road
5. Huron Street at Southcross Boulevard

WHEREAS, funding for these five locations is available from the FY 06-07 Annual Traffic Signal Installation and Traffic Signal Upgrade Program and Council District 4 HUD Section 108 District-wide Access and Mobility funds which were appropriated through previous City Council actions; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of **SAECO Electric and Utility** in the amount of \$783,821.52 in connection with the City Wide Traffic Signal Installation Project is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute a standard form contract covering said Project in substantially the same form as attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 25th day of February, 2007.




