ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION

2. That at said election the following PROPOSITION shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION

Shall the City Council of said City be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$5,500,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially in not to exceed 20 years from their date, and to bear interest at rates not to exceed 5% per annum, for the purpose of making improvements for public recreation purposes, to-wit: the construction and equipment of a tower structure, to include observation, dining, concession, and other facilities; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

3. That the official ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:

PROPOSITION

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TOWER BONDS"

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF TOWER BONDS"

4. That the City Clerk shall be the clerk for absentee voting for said election; and the office of said City Clerk in the City Hall is hereby designated as the place at which absentee voting shall be conducted for said election, during the regular office hours of said City Clerk.

5. That the Mayor shall appoint the election officers to hold said election, in accordance with law, including a special canvassing board which shall count and canvass the absentee ballots cast at said election.

6. That voting machines shall be used for absentee voting by personal appearance and also for voting at the regular Polling Places at said election; but paper ballots shall be used for absentee voting by mail.

7. That only resident, qualified electors who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation shall be entitled to vote at said election.

8. That notice of said election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Ordinance in each of the Election Precincts of said City and also at the City Hall, not less than 15 days prior to the date set for said election; and, a substantial copy of this Ordinance also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in said City, the date of the first publication to be not less than 14 days prior to the date set for said election.

9. That this Ordinance is hereby passed as an emergency measure, to be effective immediately upon enactment, such emergency being that the proceeds from the bonds to be voted on as herein provided are required as soon as possible for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, and safety.


