

AN ORDINANCE 101057

**CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF THE RUN-OFF ELECTION
HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 7, 2005.**

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the Joint General and Special Election was held on the 7th day of May 2005, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio, and for consideration of three propositions; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates were submitted, the election was held and conducted and the returns thereof were made, all as required by the City Charter and the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, at said election, no candidate for the Office of Council Member for Places 6, 7, and 11 (Mayor) received a majority of all the votes for the office sought, cast by the qualified voters voting in said election, and therefore, no candidate was elected at said election for the Office of Council Member for Places 6, 7, and 11 (Mayor); and

WHEREAS, it was necessary to order a Run-off Municipal Election for the purpose of electing the Council Members for those places; and

WHEREAS, the Run-off Election was held on the 7th day of June, 2005, to determine the Council Members for Places 6, 7, and 11 (Mayor) of the City of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to the Run-off Election, including the ordering, notices, election officers, holding, and returns thereof, and it is now necessary to declare the official results of the canvass; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council having convened on this the 17th day of June, 2005, to canvass the returns of the Run-off Election held on June 7, 2005 and after canvassing the returns of said election, officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered; proper notice of said election was duly given; proper election judges and clerks were duly appointed prior to said election; said election was duly held; the City has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act and the Texas Election Code; and the returns of said Run-off Election have been provided and delivered, all in accordance with law and the Ordinance calling the Run-off Election.

SECTION 2. The City Council does hereby officially find and declare the results of the Run-off Election to be as follows:

SECTION 3. It is further declared that as a result of said Run-off Election, the following persons were elected as Council Members:

Elena Guajardo	Member of Council	Place No. 7
Phil Hardberger	Member of Council	Place No. 11 (Mayor)

and each of them was elected by receiving a majority of all the votes cast for the office for which each was a candidate, cast by the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio voting at said election, and thus are hereby declared to be the lawful and duly elected Council Members of the City of San Antonio for the places specified.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on June 17, 2005.

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City Council as the Canvassing Authority will review the unofficial election results tabulated for the Tuesday, June 7, 2005 Run-off Election.

POLICY ANALYSIS


In accordance with Section 4 of the City Charter, a run-off election is required when none of the candidates in a particular race garners a majority of the votes cast.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost to the City of San Antonio for the run-off election is \$367,855.70. As a cost savings measure, the City of San Antonio utilized paper ballots for both Early Voting and Election Day during the Run-off Election.

COORDINATION

The City Clerk's Office has coordinated this proposed ordinance with the City Attorney's Office, Office of Management and Budget, and the Bexar County Election Administrator's Office.
