Whereas, notice has been sent to residents of the Foch Highway between Flores Street and Cincinnati Avenue, to the effect that the paving of the said highway will be started immediately and that the cost of said paving will be charged to them, therefore,

The Mayor and City Commissioners are asked to further investigate this matter before taking action, so that, owing to the situation of the property, that the residents of the above mentioned section of the Foch highway may not be penalized.

Furthermore that the Foch Highway is one of the most travelled highways in Bexar County and we believe that a large portion of the cost should be paid for out of the public funds of the City and possibly the county, taking into consideration that said highway is a continuation of the highway to Fredericksburg, Leon Springs, Blanco and other points.
