

**AN ORDINANCE      89862**

DESIGNATING CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE 1999 -2001 CITY COUNCIL AS MAYOR PRO TEM FOR SPECIFIED PERIODS OF TIME THROUGH MAY 31, 2001; AND SWEARING IN OF MAYOR PRO TEM FOR THE PERIOD JUNE 3, 1999 THROUGH AUGUST 16, 1999, AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE UPON PASSAGE OF EIGHT (8) AFFIRMATIVE VOTES.

**WHEREAS**, the City Charter in Section 9 calls for a Mayor Pro Tem to act as Mayor during the absence or disability of the Mayor; and

**WHEREAS**, a tradition has been established of rotating the Mayor Pro Tem position among all of the members of the Council other than the Mayor during each two year term; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The following named members of the City Council are hereby designated as Mayor Pro Tem of the City of San Antonio to serve during the periods indicated below:

June 3, 1999 through August 16, 1999	Debra Guerrero
August 17, 1999 through October 28, 1999	Raul Prado
October 29, 1999 through January 7, 2000	David Carpenter
January 8, 2000 through March 20, 2000	Bonnie Conner
March 21, 2000 through May 31, 2000	José Menéndez
June 1, 2000 through August 11, 2000	Rick Vásquez
August 12, 2000 through October 22, 2000	Bobby Perez
October 23, 2000 through January 3, 2001	Mario Salas
January 4, 2001 through March 18, 2001	Ed Garza
March 19, 2001 through May 31, 2001	Tim Bannwolf

**SECTION 2.** Should any of the above Council Members be replaced for any reason, such replacement shall be substituted for such member for the term indicated.

**SECTION 3.** Because of the necessity of having a Mayor Pro Tem to act in the absence of the Mayor, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage of eight (8) affirmative votes.





SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION:


