On this the 13th day of June, 1956, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, convened in special meeting, at the regular meeting place, with the following members present:
to-wit:

and with the following absent: Mayor Kuykendall and Councilman Daniels, constituting a quorum, at which time the following proceedings were had.

The Call of the meeting issued on June 8 was read.

Mayor Pro-tem Crumrine then directed the Clerk to proceed with the canvass of the returns of the election held on June 12th. When the canvass was completed and results of the election were determined, Councilman Friedrich introduced an ordinance and made a motion that it be passed. The motion was seconded by Councilman Passur. The ordinance was read in full by the City Clerk.

The motion carrying with it the passage of the ordinance prevailed by the following vote:

AYES: Councilmen Friedrich, Baines, Passur, Winton, Olivares, San Martin and Mayor Pro-tem Crumrine.

NAYS: None.

The Mayor Pro-tem announced that the ordinance had been passed. The ordinance as passed is as follows:

ORDINANCE

BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULT OF AN ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF \$20,885,000.00 WATERWORKS IMPROVEMENT AND EXTENSION REVENUE BONDS.

WHEREAS, heretofore on the 17th day of May, 1956, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, passed an ordinance calling an election to be held in said City on the 12th day of June, 1956, on the following proposition:

"Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$20,885,000.00, maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum maturity being not more than Thirty (30) years from their date, bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Four and one-half ($4\frac{1}{2}\%$) per cent per annum, for the purpose of improving and extending the City's Waterworks System, to be issued in accordance with and secured in the manner provided in Articles 1111-1118, both inclusive, of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, each bond to be conditioned that the holder thereof shall never have the right to demand payment of said obligations out of funds raised or to be raised by taxation, secured by a pledge of the net revenues from the operation of said system, and in the discretion of the City Council to be further secured by a deed of trust lien on said system and the pledge of a franchise to operate said system for a term of not exceeding twenty years in event of sale after default as provided in the power of sale contained in said mortgage."

; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly held at the time and places specified after due notice as required by law had been given by posting and publication; and

WHEREAS, there were cast at said election the following votes:

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF WATERWORKS IMPROVEMENT AND EXTENSION REVENUE BONDS" 13565 Votes;

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF WATERWORKS IMPROVEMENT AND EXTENSION REVENUE BONDS" 2608 Votes,

as is reflected in the election returns heretofore filed with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, only qualified taxpaying voters owning taxable property in said City and who had duly rendered their property for taxation were allowed to vote;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That said election was duly called; that notice was given in accordance with law and in accordance with the ordinance calling the

election; that the election was held in accordance with law; that the returns of said election have been made by the proper officers; that a majority of the qualified voters who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation voting at said election have voted in favor of the issuance of the bonds.

2. That the City Council be and it is hereby in all things authorized, ordered and directed to issue said bonds and to do any and all things necessary or convenient in connection therewith.


