

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, MARCH 12TH, A.D.1923, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Lambert and Wright. Absent, Pfeiffer, Rieden.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:
 For arc light Burnett & St. Charles Street.
 Mrs J.F Hurff, for refund of electrical permit.
 S.A.Amusement Co. for permit to erect bulletin board Hays and Austin Streets.
 Aug. G.Hornung, for permit to maintain laundry, S.Alamo and Lavaca Streets.

Petition for the improvement of Hays Street was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets.

Commissioner Wright recommended that petition of S.A.Amusement Co. for permit to erect bulletin board on Fredericksburg Road be granted. Adopted.

Commissioner Wright recommended that petition of L.C.Roosevelt for permit to erect drive-in filling station at Porter St. and New Braunfels Ave, be granted. Adopted.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the Commissioners agreed to permit the Bethany Company to purchase 200 yards of gravel from City gravel pit, at ;15¢ per cubic yard, for the purpose of gravelling a street; these parties to remove the gravel at their own expense.

Upon recommendation of the City Purchasing Agent the Standard Sanitary Mfg. Co. was awarded contract for pipe and fittings to be laid in New Braunfels Avenue for watering hedge at City cemeteries.

Upon recommendation of the City Engineer the Mistletoe Creameries was granted a permit to replace the cement walk and curb with sloping pavement in front of their property on the East side of Austin Street fronting garage.

The Mayor introduced the following ordinances, which were read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Black, Lambert, Wright.

AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Mayor of the City of San Antonio to employ the firm of Burger, and Nichols, court reporters, to act as reporters in the case of San Antonio Public Service Company vs. City of San Antonio, now pending before the Rail Road Commission of the State of Texas, and appropriating the sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary to compensate said firm for the services to be performed by it.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to employ the firm of Burger and Nichols, court reporters, to act as reporters in the case of San Antonio Public Service Company vs. City of San Antonio, now pending before the Railroad Commission of the State of Texas; and to agree to pay on behalf of the City such fees for the services to be rendered by them as are not in excess of the fees provided by law to be paid for similar services in the reporting of cases in the District Courts of the State of Texas.

SECTION TWO: That the sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund to be charged to contingencies for the payment of the services herein provided and authorized to be contracted for. Provided, however, that no warrant shall be issued against said fund until after the services for which warrant is drawn have actually been performed and the bill therefor approved by the City Attorney and the Mayor of the City of San Antonio.

AN ORDINANCE

Granting to the San Antonio and Aransas Pass Railway Company the right to construct, maintain and operate a railroad spur track and to operate its engines and cars thereon across Lombano Street in the City of San Antonio, Texas, from a point in the south line of Block 1018, etc.

AN ORDINANCE

THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 COUNTY OF BEXAR:

WHEREAS, at the intersection of the right-of-way of the San Antonio and Aransas Pass Railway Company and the Fredericksburg Road, within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, it has ~~been~~ become necessary to provide for the disposition of storm waters accumulated at said point:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, Texas that the San Antonio and Aransas Pass Railway Company be and it is hereby ordered and directed to construct a concrete spillway under its track at the crossing of the Fredericksburg Road and the tracks of said Railway Company in accordance with the plans and specifications attached hereto and expressly made a part hereof,
