

AN ORDINANCE 53288

CALLING THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 4, 1981 IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MEMBERS TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND ON A PROPOSED BOND ISSUE FOR RESTORING MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. That the regular municipal election and a bond election be, and the same are ordered hereby to be held on Saturday, the 4th day of April, A.D., 1981, in accordance with the laws of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, for the election of the following municipal officers, to-wit:

Ten Members of the Council, Place 1 through Place 10, being one each to be elected from districts or wards numbered accordingly (all as provided by Section 4 of the City Charter of the City of San Antonio), each for a term of two years beginning on the first day of May, 1981; and One Member to be elected as Mayor, Place 11, by a majority of all qualified voters voting in said election as provided in Section 4 and 9 of the City Charter of the City of San Antonio.

SECTION 2. That at said election the following PROPOSITION shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$9,412,000 with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of making improvements for public purposes, to-wit: restoring the Municipal Auditorium; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy, and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

SECTION 3. The official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION, with the ballots

to contain such provisions, markings, and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITION to be expressed substantially as follows:

SECTION 4. Said election shall be held as prescribed by law, in the City of San Antonio at the following polling or voting places in the several precincts of the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M.:

SECTION 5. Voting at said election shall be done by the use of voting machines, paper ballots, or the electronic voting system as determined by the City Clerk, and the City Council of the City of San Antonio does determine hereby that voting machines, paper ballots or electronic voting system shall be used for the casting of absentee votes at this election, and voting machines shall be placed in the Office of the City Clerk, in the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas, and at those temporary branch offices established for the purpose of conducting absentee voting by personal appearance as approved by the City Council of San Antonio through the passage of Ordinance No. 53256 of January 15, 1981; and the City Clerk, or any Assistant City Clerk, is authorized and charged to perform the functions provided by law in the casting of absentee ballots and shall hold such election, and ballots shall be cast commencing March 16, 1981, and ending March 31, 1981; all in the method, manner and time made and provided by the Statutes of the State of Texas on this project.

SECTION 6. The Mayor shall appoint the election officers to hold said election, in accordance with law, including a special canvassing board which shall count and canvass the absentee ballots cast at said election.

SECTION 7. Notice of the regular municipal election shall be given by publishing a substantial copy of this Ordinance in a daily newspaper of general circulation published in the City, not less than 30 days before the date of the election.

SECTION 8. Notice of said bond election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Ordinance at three (3) public places in the City of San Antonio and also at the City Hall, not less than 15 days prior to the date set for said election; and a substantial copy of this Ordinance also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio, the date of the first publication to be not less than 14 days prior to the date set for said election.

SECTION 9. All bonds voted at said election shall be issued only in accordance with, and subject to all restrictions and requirements of, all applicable law.

SECTION 10. All resident, qualified electors of the City of San Antonio shall be entitled to vote at said election.
