Commissioner Hein introduced a resolution ordering the removal of all marked graves from an abandoned burial ground on City property at Nebraska Street and New Braunfels Avenue to a location in San Jose Cemetery. He accepted an amendment, offered by Commissioner Steffler, stipulating that no action be taken on the removal until 10 days after passage of this resolution.

Commissioner Hein explained that this burial ground is an old "potters' field" which has been abandoned for more than 20 years, with no burials there in at least that length of time. He said it is desired to remove the marked and identifiable graves to San Jose Cemetery in order that they may have proper care.

Commissioner Anderson stated it was his belief that this burial ground had been ordered removed at the time San Jose Cemetery was opened.

Mayor Mauermann insisted that all graves bearing markers be moved with due respect and properly re-interred and recorded at San Jose. He asked that an effort be made to locate all graves in the old burial ground and move them to San Jose.

After a second by Commissioner Callaghan, the resolution, as amended, was passed by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler & Anderson.
