

MARCH 7, 1947

MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS, SITTING AS A COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE, HELD IN THE OFFICE OF THE STREET COMMISSIONER, AT 11:00 O'CLOCK, A.M., ON FRIDAY, MARCH THE SEVENTH, A.D. 1947.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson; Mayor Mauermann presiding.

Pursuant to their agreement of the previous day, the Mayor and Commissioners met as a Committee of the Whole, in the Office of the Street Commissioner, at 11:00 O'clock, A.M., on Friday, March 7, 1947, and considered and acted upon the following matters:

Bench Advertising Co., Detroit, Mich., petition to place advertising benches at bus stops; voted, by unanimous "aye" vote, to deny the petition for the present fiscal year.

Miss Tennessee M. Bivings, et al, petition for removal of salvage area (junk yard) at S. New Braunfels Ave. and Dakota St.; voted, by unanimous "aye" vote, to refer to City Attorney with instructions to take proper action.

S. D. Hopkins, on behalf of Max Moellinger, petition to close and purchase Cloonan Pl., or clean and gravel that street; referred to City Engineer with instructions to investigate and report back to Committee of the Whole.

Mrs. J. Z. Norris, offer to sell to City a strip of property on Gladstone Ave., in NCB 3735; referred to City Engineer to investigate and report back to Committee of the Whole.

Letter of J. W. Beretta Engineers, dated Nov. 27, 1946, offering to present a flood control program to the Mayor and Commissioners. Letter read in full by the Clerk and discussed at length by the Mayor and Commissioners. The City Clerk was instructed to write and thank Beretta Engrs. for the calling of this matter to the attention of the Council and invite them to meet with the Council at a mutually convenient time and go into the matter fully.

William W. Woods, et al, Petition asking improvements in Elmendorf Lake Area; voted to hold in abeyance until overall plan of flood control is worked out.

Petition of Board of Education of Los Angeles Heights Ind. School Dist. to acquire land in NCB 8339, 8346 and 8347 for a school site. Following discussion, the Clerk was instructed to contact petitioners and see if they are still interested in obtaining this property.

Petition of R. L. White Co. to close part of Olmos Drive between island and CB 7279. Comm. Anderson said he would recommending the closing, to eliminate a traffic hazard, if the street was not paved, and, if paved, provided the petitioner would reimburse the City for the paving. Following discussion, the petition was referred to Comm. Steffler to investigate and make a recommendation, and to Comm. Callaghan to have an appraisal made.

There followed discussion of proposed extension of the City limits, by annexation, to the Wurzbach Highway on the Austin Highway. On motion of Comm. Anderson, seconded by Comm. Steffler and carried by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson, the City Engineer was instructed to prepare the necessary field notes and the City Attorney to draw the annexation ordinance.

Petition of Mrs. M. W. Toland, et al, to change the name of Donehue St. to East Park Ave. Recommended by City Engineer. On motion of Comm. Hein, duly seconded and carried by unanimous "aye" vote, referred to City Attorney to prepare the necessary ordinance.

City Engineer Coghill informed the Mayor and Commissioners it had been found necessary to relocate a 21-inch sanitary sewer on the first unit of the Interregional Highway, and estimated this would cost \$25,000. The matter was deferred for further investigation and discussion.

Pursuant to motion duly made and carried, the meeting was adjourned.
