When the following proceedings were had to-wit:

In the matter of the action of the Court upon bids for the furnishing hardware for the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital.

The bids for the furnishing of finishing hardware for the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital were taken up by the Court and the representatives of the bidders, the Braunschweig Briam Reich Company, Peden Iron and Steel Company, W. E. Huffaker, Moody and Harmon, Praeger Hardware Company, were allowed to exhibit their samples and explain the merits of same, and upon the motion of City Commissioner J. R. Lambert seconded by County Commissioner J. K. Lamm, all members present voting "Aye",.
