

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

FRIDAY, MAY 19TH., A. D. 1922. 4 P. M.

PRESENT: Hon. Jno. P. Pfeiffer, Mayor Pro-tem, Presiding, and Commissioners, Lambert, Rieden, Wright. Absent, O. B. Black, Mayor.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City of San Antonio does hereby accept the paving constructed by the Uvalde Rock Asphalt Company on Austin Street, from Carson to Grayson Street, as per contract dated Dec. 5th., 1921, with no omissions, and the same is accepted in accordance with report of the City Engineer, dated May 19th 1922, and filed with the Board of Commissioners on this the 19th day of May 1922.
