

AN ORDINANCE      2014 - 12 - 11 - 1007

**ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT INCLUDING AN ADDITIVE ALTERNATE IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,806,946.35 TO CAPITAL EXCAVATION COMPANY FOR CONSTRUCTION OF INGRAM ROAD FROM CULEBRA TO MABE, A 2012-2017 BOND-FUNDED PROJECT, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6, AND OF THIS AMOUNT, \$348,355.00 WILL BE REIMBURSED BY SAN ANTONIO WATER SYSTEMS.**

**WHEREAS**, this Project provides for the reconstruction and widening of approximately one half mile of Ingram Road from Culebra to Mabe to four 11-foot lanes, including 4 foot concrete raised median, curbs, sidewalks, driveway approaches, and approximately 1,700 linear feet of dedicated bicycle lanes from Mabe to Culebra to provide connectivity to existing bicycle lanes along Culebra Road; and

**WHEREAS**, this Project ties into the Ingram Road Low Water Crossing Project that was completed in May 2012 by Bexar County in which a 1,716 foot bridge was built and the roadway was increased to 4 lanes; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by **Capital Excavation Company** in the amount not to exceed \$4,806,946.35 for construction of Ingram Road from Culebra to Mabe; and

**WHEREAS**, of the total contract amount, the City will be reimbursed an amount up to \$348,355.00 by San Antonio Water System; and

**WHEREAS**, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 2012 Bond funded projects; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The lowest responsive bid of **Capital Excavation Company** in the amount not to exceed \$4,806,946.35 for construction of Ingram Road from Culebra to Mabe is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

**SECTION 2.** A construction contract is hereby awarded to **Capital Excavation Company**.

**SECTION 3.** The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funds are authorized to be received from SAWS to SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00307, Ingram Road (Culebra Road to Mabe Road), and the budget shall be revised by increasing WBS element 40-00307-90-

08, SAWS Contribution and SAP General Ledger 4502280, Contribution from other Agencies, in the amount of \$348,355.00.

- b) The amount of \$58,794.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00307, Ingram Road (Culebra Road to Mabe Road), SAP WBS Element 40-00307-05-02-03, Construction-SAWS Sewers and SAP General Ledger 5201245.
- c) The amount of \$289,561.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00307, Ingram Road (Culebra Road to Mabe Road), SAP WBS Element 40-00307-05-02-04, Construction-SAWS Water and SAP General Ledger 5201245
- d) Payment in the amount not to exceed \$4,806,946.35 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00307, Ingram Road (Culebra Road to Mabe Road), is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Capital Excavation Company**, for construction services.
- e) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.


