

AN ORDINANCE **2010-06-10-0525**

CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010 WHICH WOULD EXTEND THE CURRENT 1/8TH SALES TAX FOR THE EDWARDS AQUIFER PROTECTION AND PARKS DEVELOPMENT & EXPANSION VENUE PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas desires to provide for the planning, acquisition, establishment, development, construction, monitoring, maintenance or renovation of a venue project as authorized by, and defined in, Chapter 334, Texas Local Government Code, as amended, which includes the acquisition of property for a conservation easement or open-space preservation program intended to protect water in the Edwards Aquifer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas desires to provide for the planning, acquisition, establishment, development, construction, monitoring, maintenance or renovation of a venue project as authorized by, and defined in, Chapter 334, Texas Local Government Code, as amended, which includes the acquisition of open space and linear parks along San Antonio's Creekways, specifically including Leon Creek, Salado Creek, Apache Creek, Alazan Creek, Martinez Creek, San Pedro Creek, the Medina River and the San Antonio River and for improvements and additions to the Municipal Parks and Recreation System; and

WHEREAS, if the Venue Projects described in this ordinance are approved by the voters, the City may use money received from the sales and use tax approved by the voters to reimburse or pay the costs of planning, acquiring, establishing, developing, constructing, monitoring, maintaining or renovating such approved Venue Projects, or pay the principal and interest on, and other costs relating to bonds or other obligations issued by the City to finance the Venue Projects; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 334, Section 334.021, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2010-05-06-0021R on May 6, 2010, designating the Venue Projects and designating the method of financing for such Venue Projects; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 334, Section 334.024, authorizes the City to order an election on the question of approving and implementing this Resolution and approving this Venue Projects and the method of financing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 334, Section 334.022, the City, before calling such election, sent a copy of this Resolution to the State Comptroller, who has (1) performed an analysis to determine if approval and implementation of this Resolution will have a significant negative fiscal impact on state revenue, and (2) provided to the City written notice of the results of the analysis; and

WHEREAS, the Comptroller, by letter dated May 27th, 2010, determined, and the City has received written confirmation, that implementation of this Resolution will not have a significant negative impact on state revenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may now order an election on the question of approving and implementing the Venue Projects Resolution which designates, and provides for the planning, acquisition, establishment, development, construction, monitoring, maintenance or renovation of, and the method of financing for the *EDWARDS AQUIFER PROTECTION VENUE PROJECT* and the *PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT*; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an election should be held under the authority of Chapter 334 on the question of implementing and approving this Resolution and imposing a sales and use tax for the purposes identified in this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates entering into a Contract for Election Services with the Bexar County elections Administrator under the authority of Subchapter D of Chapter 31, Texas Election Code, for the conduct of this ordered election; and

WHEREAS, it is officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of the meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. DATE; OFFICIAL PROPOSITIONS. An election shall be held on Tuesday, the 2nd day of November, 2010, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, including Chapter 334, Texas Local Government Code, as amended, the Texas Election Code, as amended, and the provisions of the charter of the City of San Antonio. The official ballots for this election shall be prepared in accordance with Chapter 334 and the Texas Election Code and at this election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with the law:

THE EDWARDS AQUIFER PROTECTION VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION

PROPOSITION NO. 1

“Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to implement Resolution No. 2010-05-06-0021R, which provides for the planning, acquisition, establishment, development, construction, monitoring, maintenance or renovation of, and method of financing for the **“Edwards Aquifer Protection Venue Project,”** which includes the acquisition of property for a conservation easement or open-space preservation program intended to protect water in the Edwards Aquifer, and to impose a sales and use tax at the rate of one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 1%) (a portion of which tax shall be shared with and used for the **“Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project”** if such venue project is also approved by the voters) for the purpose of financing the **“Edwards Aquifer Protection Venue Project”** in an amount not to exceed \$90 million (including costs of issuance and interest on bonds or other obligations, if any), upon the full collection of sales and use tax authorized by the voters on May

7, 2005 for the Edwards Aquifer Protection Project as Proposition 1 and for the Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project as Proposition 2?”

**THE PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION
PROPOSITION NO. 2**

“Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to implement Resolution No. 2010-05-06-0021R, which provides for the planning, acquisition, establishment, development, construction, monitoring, maintenance or renovation of, and method of financing for the **“Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project,”** which includes the acquisition of open space and linear parks along San Antonio’s creekways, specifically including Leon Creek, Salado Creek, Apache Creek, Alazan Creek, Martinez Creek, San Pedro Creek, the Medina River and the San Antonio River and for improvements and additions to the Municipal Parks and Recreation System, and to impose a sales and use tax at the rate of one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 1%) (a portion of which tax shall be shared with and used for the **“Edwards Aquifer Protection Venue Project”** if such venue project is also approved by the voters) for the purpose of financing the **“Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project”** in an amount not to exceed \$45 million (including costs of issuance and interest on bonds or other obligations, if any), upon the full collection of sales and use tax authorized by the voters on May 7, 2005 for the Edwards Aquifer Protection Project as Proposition 1 and for the Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project as Proposition 2?”

SECTION 2. FORM OF BALLOTS. The official ballots for this election shall be prepared in accordance with Chapter 334, Texas Local Government Code and the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote “FOR” or “AGAINST” the aforesaid PROPOSITIONS, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings, and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITIONS to be expressed substantially as follows:

**THE EDWARDS AQUIFER PROTECTION VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION
PROPOSITION NO. 1**

FOR } Authorizing the City of San Antonio to protect water quality in the Edwards Aquifer by establishing a watershed protection and preservation project known as the **“Edwards Aquifer Protection Venue Project”** to acquire and preserve land or interests in land in the Edwards Aquifer recharge and contributing zones both inside and outside Bexar County, and to impose a sales and use tax at the rate of one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 1%), (a portion of which tax shall be shared with and used for the **“Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project”** if such venue project is also approved by the voters), in an amount not to exceed \$90 million (including costs of issuance and interest on bonds or other obligations, if any), for the purpose of financing the **“Edwards Aquifer Protection Venue Project”**, upon the full collection of sales and use tax

Authorizing the City of San Antonio to establish the *“Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project”* which includes the acquisition of open space and linear parks along San Antonio’s creekways, specifically including Leon Creek, Salado Creek, Apache Creek, Alazan Creek, Martinez Creek, San Pedro Creek, the Medina River and the San Antonio River and for improvements and additions to the Municipal Parks and Recreation System, and to impose a sales and use tax at the rate of one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 1%) (a portion of which tax shall be shared with and used for the *“Edwards Aquifer Protection Venue project”* if such venue project is also approved by the voters), in an amount not to exceed \$45 million (including costs of issuance and interest on bonds or other obligations, if any), for the purpose of financing the *“Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project”* upon the full collection of sales and use tax authorized by the voters on May 7, 2005 for the Edwards Aquifer Protection Project as Proposition 1 and for the Parks Development and Expansion Venue Project as Proposition 2.

AGAINST }

SECTION 3. PRECINTS AND POLLING PLACES; TIME. This election shall be held as prescribed by law, in the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o’clock a.m. and 7:00 o’clock p.m. on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, at those locations listed in **Attachment I**. Attachment I is attached to and incorporated in this Ordinance for all purposes.

SECTION 4. EARLY VOTING. Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the branch offices as listed in **Attachment II**, which is attached to and incorporated in this Ordinance for all purposes, during the period of early voting, commencing Monday, October 18, 2010 and ending Friday, October 29, 2010, during the hours indicated in **Attachment II**. Electors may cast their early vote by mail, and the early voting clerk’s mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail shall be sent to, is as follows:

SECTION 5. VOTING SYSTEM. Voting at said election for Election Day voting shall be done by the use of the iVotronic™ touch screen voting system, as hereby determined by the City Clerk of the City of San Antonio and the Bexar County Elections Administrator. The equipment shall be placed at the Election Day polling locations listed in **Attachment I**. The City Clerk and the Bexar County Elections Administrator further determine that AIS 650 Tabulators and paper ballots shall be used for the casting of early votes by mail and for the casting of provisional ballots during Early Voting and on Election Day. Voting at said election for Early Voting by personal appearance shall be done by the use of the iVotronic™ touch screen voting system. The equipment shall be placed at branch offices as listed in **Attachment II**, established for the purpose of conducting Early Voting by personal appearance.

SECTION 6. CONTRACT FOR ELECTION SERVICES. The City Council will enter into an Elections Services Contract with the Bexar County Elections Administrator to conduct this election, which will be approved by the City Council under authority of the Texas Election Code. This contract shall be considered by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, as evidenced by passage of an ordinance.

SECTION 7. NOTICE. *(a) Form of Notice of Election.* The City Clerk of the City of San Antonio is authorized and directed to prepare a form of the Notice of Election in both English and Spanish, the contents of which comply with the requirements of Section 4.004 of the Texas Election Code (and other applicable law), and include at a minimum the nature and date of the election, the form of the propositions included in Section 1 of this Ordinance, the form of the ballot propositions included in Section 2 of this Ordinance, the location of each election day and early voting polling place, the locations, dates, and times of temporary branch locations of early voting, the hours the polls will be open, and any other information required by other law, and with such variations permitted by applicable law.

(b) Method of Giving Notice. Notice of this election shall be given by posting a copy of the Notice of Election, both in English and in Spanish, not later than the 21st day before the date set for this election on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council of the City. Notice of this election shall also be given by publishing the Notice of Election, both in English and in Spanish, at least once, not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day before Election Day, in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio. It is found and declared that the San Antonio Express-News is a newspaper of general circulation within the City.

SECTION 8. ELECTORS; BILINGUAL ELECTION MATERIALS. All resident, qualified electors of the City shall be permitted to vote at the election, and on the day of the election such electors shall vote at the designated polling place. The election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and the provisions of Chapter 334 of the Texas Local Government code, as amended, and as may be required by any other law. All election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.

SECTION 9. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS. The statements contained in recitals included in the preamble of this Ordinance are found to be true and correct, and such recitals are incorporated into, and made a part of, this Ordinance for all purposes and are adopted as part of the judgment and findings of the City Council.


SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application thereof to other circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City Council declares that this Ordinance would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance is effective immediately, upon passage by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise the effective date shall be ten (10) days from the date of passage.






