

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, MAY 24th, A.D.1923, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Jno. P. Pfeiffer, Mayor Pro-tem presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Rieden, Wright. Absent, Mayor Black.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation: E.N.Brackenridge, for correction of assessment. John F.Smith, for refund of taxes.

Petition of R.A.Menger, for refund of building license was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

The City Engineer recommended that the bid of Elder Construction Co. for building bridge over river on Lakeview Avenue be accepted. Adopted.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating money to pay for band concert.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.) be hereby appropriated to defray the expense of the band concerts held in Brackenridge Park during week ending May 12, 1923. To be charged to Zoo Fund.

AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400) be hereby appropriated to defray the expenses of the band concerts held in Brackenridge Park from May 13 to 19 inc. To be charged to Zoo Fund.
