

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 1916, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert, Kearny and Uhr.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS-----

Petition of Citizens for water mains on Stafford Street, was read and ordered filed.

Petition of A.Berman, complaining of drainage conditions, was read and referred to City Engineer.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: San Antonio Poster Adv. Co., for permit to erect two bill boards on N.Laredo Street, near W.Cypress Street.

Citizens, complaining of bill board next-to 214 Avenue E.

Young Mens Christian Association, for permit to erect a bicycle rack in front of their Hall.

Petition of Sunset System for refund of amount paid for building permits, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Commissioner Garland introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Brown, Garland, Lambert, Kearny and Uhr. Nays, none.

An ordinance granting permit to L.W.Gillette to operate Car No. 10467 in Local Street Transportation.

On motion of Commissioner Garland, duly seconded and carried, the City Clerk was directed to advertise for bids for the construction of a fire proof vault in the office of the City Collector, said bids to be received until 4 O'clock P.M. on Sept. 28, 1916.

Commissioner Kearny introduced the following resolution, which was read and adopted:

RESOLUTION

Accepting the pavement on River Avenue from Grand Avenue to Grayson Street.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City of San Antonio does hereby accept the pavement constructed by the Texas Bithulitic Company on River Avenue from Grand Avenue to Grayson Street, with no omissions, the date of acceptance being hereby fixed on the 21st day of September, 1916, in accordance with the certificate of the City Engineer, filed with the City Council on September 21st, 1916.

Commissioner Kearny recommended that the petition for extension of Sanitary sewer on Drexel Avenue be granted when funds are available. Adopted.

Commissioner Kearny recommended that petition of E.A. Mayor for reduction of paving assessment on account of South Presa Streer paving be not granted, as cost of paving is only 24% of the assessed value of the property. Adopted.

A proposal made by the San Antonio Belt and Terminal Railway Company to move four car loads of garbage for the City daily for a period of ten years was read and referred to the City Attorney.

Commissioner Lambert introduced the following resolution, which was read and adopted:

A RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of the Golf Club House according to plans and specifications on file with the Architect, Emmett T. Jackson, said work to be completed within sixty days, the City reserving the right to reject any and all bids.

Petition of H. Rodriguez for permit to conduct a meat market at Laredo and San Fernando Street was granted on recommendation of City Health Officer.

Commissioner Uhr recommended that the following petitions for permit to install gasoline tanks be granted, provided that consent of owner of property is first obtained.

E. W. Jackson, 3701 S. Flores Street.

Chas M. Cain, 1516 Grayson Street. Adopted.

Commissioner Uhr recommended that petition of Elite Cafe for permit to erect ~~elec~~tric sign at 224 Losoya Street be not granted. Adopted.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
