Present: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert, Kearny and Uhr.

Appropriating \$700.00 to pay Rushmore and Gowdy.

Be it ordained by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Seven Hundred (\$700.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Paving Fund to make final payment to Rushmore & Gowdy for work done on Plum Street (Hoefgen Ave.) from Santa Clara Street to Goliad Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of TwentyFive Hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Paving Fund to pay the Western Paving

Company for paving Lafitte Street from Water Street to Santa Clara Street.

This additional amount is required on account of change in width of street to be paved, and the paving in front of City Park and School House.

This additional appropriation being made necessary on account of cuts and fills for gas and water connections, which amount will be collected from the Gas and Water Companies.

AN ORDINANCE - 793

Directing that the contract awarded to Colglazier Construction Company on the 18th day of February, 1916 for the paving of Carson Street from Austin Street to New Braunfels Avenue be divided at Pine Street.

WHEREAS on the 18th day of February 1916, in conformity with the ordinance accepting the bid of and authorizing contract with Colglazier Construction Company, a contract was duly executed by the City of San Antonio with Colglazier Construction Company, and the required bonds made and accepted, for the paving of Carson Street from Austin Street to New Braunfels Avenue, and;

WHEREAS it is intended, and so published, to assess and charge against the

property owners two different rates per front foot for this paving- one rate from Austin Street to Pine Street and another rate from Pine Street to New Braunfels Avenue, as shown by the published notice of public hearing and the ordinance levying assessments against property owners on said street, and:

WHEREAS it is accordingly deemed proper to have two distinct and separate contracts with said Colglazier Construction Company covering the same work so awarded and included in said hearing and assessment;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commissioners of the City of San Antonio that the Mayor be , and he is hereby authorized, directed and empowered to execute and sign one contract with Colglazier Construction Company covering the paving and curbing of Carson Street from Austin Street to the west line of Pine Street, and one contract with Colglazier Construction Company covering the paving and curbing of Carson Street from the west line of Pine Street to New Braunfels Avenue, each of said contracts to refer back to the bid and specifications upon which the contract of February 18th 1916 was made and to said contract; each of said contract to bear date of February 18, 1916 the same as, and, taken together, to stand in lieu of and in the place of, said first mentioned contract of February 18, 1916, each of said contracts to have the usual bonds for construction and maintenance of the work included in such contract, the aggregate of such new bonds to equal the amount of the bonds already given, and said respective new bonds to be each for an amount representing a due proportion of the cost of the work included in the contract to which such bond is attached, the same as if each contract had been originally awarded separate from each other; and said new bonds shall stand in lieu of and in substitution for the bonds attached to said contract previously executed, which original bonds shall then be delivered to Colglazier Construction Company and considered cancelled.
