AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE CONVEYANCE OF ANNIE M. SULLIVAN TO WIDEN ALLEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That in consideration of the conveyance to the City of San Antonio, of a tract of land by Annie M. Sullivan for the widening of an alley in New City Block 432; the City of San Antonio will move back the fence in the alley between Fourth Street and Fifth Street as far as the garage or barn now located on Lot r, New City Block 432, and construct a new fence with proper gate along the entire width of the lot without cost to Annie M. Sullivan; the City will pave the alley from Fourth Street to Fifth Street without cost to Annie M. Sullivan and at the expense of the City; and the City will construct a ramp in the sidewalk on the Broadway front of Lot 4 at a point adjacent to the San Antonio Light Building to connect the several sidewalk levels, without cost to Annie M. Sullivan and at the expense of the City of San Antonio.

2. The deed of Annie M. Sullivan conveying to the City of San Antonio a strip of land 50.5 feet wide off the east end of Lot 4, New City Block 432, dated the 5th day of February, 1931, is hereby accepted and the City Clerk is ordered to record it, and the City Engineer and City Assessor are ordered to change their records to conform.
