AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE 500 BLOCK OF PEREZ STREET BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF HAVEN FOR HOPE WAY AND ENDING AT THE RAILROAD TRACK ABUTTING THE HAVEN FOR HOPE CAMPUS TO BE RENAMED HARDBERGER WAY AND WAIVING PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE CITY CODE FOR THE RENAMING OF STREETS.

WHEREAS, a request for consideration of a proposal to rename a segment of "Perez Street" as "Hardberger Way" in honor of Mayor Phil Hardberger's contributions to the creation of the Haven for Hope was received by the Director of Planning and Development Services; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. Street renaming procedural requirements established by the City Code are hereby waived.


