AN ORDINANCE *-711*

APPROVING THE LOCATION OF CERTAIN TRACTS OF THE INTERNATIONAL-GREAT NORTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY ON SALADO STREET.

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of November, A. D. 1926, the City of San Antonio authrozed the International-Great Northern Railroad Company to construct, maintain and operate certain tracks across Commerce Street, Buena Vista Street and other streets in the immediate vicinity; and,

WHEREAS, the said Railroad has submitted a plan for the arrangement of its main line tracks

on Salado Street between Buena Vista Street and Commerce Street, for approval; NOW THEREFORE:-

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That subject to the stipulations in said Ordinance aforesaid, the location of the tracks of the International-Great Northern Railroad Company are approved as indicated; and that the International Great Northern Railroad Company be and is hereby authorized to lay and maintain railroad tracks over and along Salado Street, between Commerce Street and the North and San Luis Street on the South, in conformity with and as designated by the attached map which constitutes a part of and made a part of this Ordinance.

2. The Tracks so permitted to be laid and maintained in the future are shown and designated by the yellow lines on said map on Salado Street, between Commerce Street and San Luis Street. The red lines on said map, between Commerce Street and San Luis Street show the present tracks on Salado Street, between the points mentioned, which said tracks so shown by red lines are to be removed and the tracks in the future here permitted to be laid, designated by yellow lines shall be laid in conformity with said map. The tracks of the Railroad Company between said points other than here designated, are not effected by this Ordinance.

AUTHORIZING THE RELOCATION OF RIVER ROAD, THE ABANDONMENT OF THE PRESENT AREA THEREOF AS A STREET AND CONVEYANCE THEREOF; AND THE EXTENSION OF EAST ELMIRA STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the street known as the River Road, bounded on the North and West by City Block No. A-2, between West Josephine Street and East Ashby Street, and on the East and Southeast by City property, be relocated by being moved in an Easterly direction so that, when established in the new location, said street will be a continuation of East Elmira Street; and,

2. That said part of said street as it now exists be and the same is hereby abandoned and closed by the City of San Antonio;

3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Deed of Exchange to that part of the River Road herein abandoned and closed to D. D. Harrigan and Walter G. Lehr for and in consideration of a tract of land in New City Block No. 3029, between West Josephine Street and West Grayson Street, for the extension of East Elmira Street.

4. That the said River Road as herein located and established, and that East Elmira Street, as herein opened and established, are dedicated to public use as a street; and the City Engineer and the City Assessor are hereby directed to file correct and revised copies of New City Block No. 3029 and City Block A-2, showing the street lines and property lines as herein specified.

5. The above and foregoing ordinance is passed and approved as a matter of public necessity and convenience, it being for the best interest of the City to abandon and relocate the River Road as herein described and to extend and open East Elmira Street as herein described.

6. Acceptance of this ordinance shall be effected by any act of the parties hereto in accomplishment of this change.
