AN ORDINANCE 5 679 4

CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING
THE RESULTS OF THE BOND ELECTION HELD
ON APRIL 2, 1983.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the City Council of the CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS (the "City") ordered an election to be held in the City on April 2, 1983 for the purpose of determining whether the resident, qualified electors of the City would authorize the issuance of bonds by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to such election, including the ordering, notice, election officers, holding an returns thereof; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held and conducted such election have duly made the returns of the results of such election, and such returns have been duly delivered to and canvassed by the City Council of the City; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Conduct of Election. The City Council of the City officially finds, determines and declares that such election was duly and properly ordered, that proper legal notice of such election was duly given in the English language and the Spanish language, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to the election, that the election was duly and legally held, that all resident, qualified electors of the City were permitted to vote at the election, that due returns of the results of the election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council of the City has duly canvassed such returns, all in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and of the United States of America, the City Charter of the City and the ordinance calling such election.

SECTION 2. Election Returns. The City Council of the City officially finds, determines, and declares that the following votes were cast at the election on the following proposition by the resident, qualified electors of the District who voted at the election.

SECTION 3. Declaration of Results of Election. The City Council of the City officially finds, determines, and declares that a majority of the resident qualified electors of the City who voted at the election have voted in favor of the issuance of bonds referred to in the Proposition and the levying of the tax for payment thereof; that therefore the election has resulted favorably to the issuance of such

bonds; and that the City Council of the City shall be authorized to issue such bonds.

SECTION 4. Emergency. This Ordinance is hereby passed as an emergency measure, to be effective immediately upon enactment, such emergency being that the proceeds from the sale of the proposed bonds are required as soon as possible for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, and safety.

SECTION 5. Open Meeting. The City Council officially finds, determines, recites, and declares that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place, and subjects of this meeting of the City Council was posted at a place convenient and readily accessible at all times to the general public at the City Hall of the City for the time required by law preceeding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Law, Article 6252-17, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, as amended; and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Ordinance and the subject matter thereof has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The City Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.
