MONDAY, AUGUST 6TH, A. D. 1917, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert, Heuermann and Lowther.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition of Paul G. Schumann for refund of part of Retail Liquor License was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Petition of H.W.Fuos, complaining of bill board on High School property on Garden Street, was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Petition for repair of Rehmann Street was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

The following letter was submitted by City Engineer.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City of San Antonio does hereby accept the pavement constructed by the Woolley Construction Company on Durango Street, from South Flores Street and South Laredo Street, with no omissions, the date of acceptance being hereby fixed on the 6th day of August, 1917, in accordance with the certificate of the City Engineer, filed with the Board of Commissioners on August 6, 1917.

MB-758 AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the McKenzie Construction Company for the construction of a sanitary sewer pumping station, in connection with the sanitary sewer now being laid by the U.S. Government from Camp Travis.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

Commissioner Garland recommended that petition of Ed. Rand and J.H. Frost for refund of taxes be granted. Adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, to improve the water distribution on each side of south flores street and in general in the south west portion of the City the following mains are hereby ordered laid.

Sommerset Road from the creek to Pecan Place.
Edwards Street-Sommerset Road to Baylor Street.
Baylor Street-Edwards street to Lipan Street.
DeWitt Street- Baylor Street to Ripford Street.
Ripford Street- DeWitt Street to Lama Street.
Lamm Street- Ripford Street to Fairmount Street.
Fairmont Street-Lamm Street to Golondrina Street-
Golondrina Street-Fairmont Street to Glenn Street.
Glenn Street-Golondrina Street to South Flores Street.
Fredericksburg Road-Woodlawn to Warner.
