No.217 *MJ-26* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$190.39 to pay Eickenroht and Cocke, Architects fee of 5% on Stage Scenery, equipment and drapery on Small Auditorium in San Pedro Park.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the sum of \$190.39, or as much thereof as is necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Park Improvement Fund of 1928, and out of the General Fund 1929, Public Welfare Department to pay Eickenroht and Cocke 5% Architectural services rendered on Stage Scenery, Equipment and Drapery on Small Auditorium in San Pedro Park, San Antonio.
2. Three and One-half ($3\frac{1}{2}$) per cent when the plans and specifications are completed and accepted; One-half ($;\frac{1}{2}$) per cent upon the acceptance by the City of the completed work.
3. Sixty (60) per cent of said sum of money appropriated shall be apid out of the Park Improvement Fund of 1928.
4. Forty (40) per cent of said sum of money appropriated shall be paid out of the General Fund 1929 Public Welfare Department.
