

Ordinance No. 51760

ORDINANCE CANVASSING RETURNS AND
DECLARING RESULTS OF ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS §

CITY OF SAN ANTONIO §

WHEREAS, the City Council of the CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS (the "City") ordered an election to be held in the City on January 26, 1980, for the purpose of determining whether the resident, qualified electors of the City would authorize the issuance of bonds by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to such election, including the ordering, notice, election officers, holding and returns thereof; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held and conducted such election have duly made the returns of the results of such election, and such returns have been duly delivered to and canvassed by the City Council of the City; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS:

Section 1: Conduct of Election. The City Council of the City officially finds, determines and declares that such election was duly and properly ordered, that proper legal notice of such election was duly given in the English language and the Spanish language, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to the election, that the election was duly and legally held, that all resident, qualified electors of the City were permitted to vote at the election, that due returns of the results of the election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council of the City has duly canvassed such returns, all in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and of the United States of America, the City Charter of the City and the ordinance calling such election.

Section 2: Election Returns. The City Council of the City officially finds, determines and declares that the following votes were cast at the election on the following proposition by the resident, qualified electors of the District who voted at the election:

The City Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.
