

AN ORDINANCE

MAKING A CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY OF
BEXAR FOR RENTAL OF VOTING MACHINES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

- 1. The attached contract executed by Charles W. Anderson, County Judge of Bexar County, ~~is accepted as~~ making and manifesting ^a ~~the~~ contract between the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar for the rental of approximately ¹⁷⁴ 220 voting machines for the Election to be held on the 8th day of ~~May~~ ^{Oct} 1951 and ~~Run Off Election on May 22 if~~ required. ^{is accepted}
- 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the acceptance of this contract.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, on the 17 day of June 1940, entered an order under the provisions of Article 2997a Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, as amended, directing that voting machines be the medium of voting in all elections to be held in said County aforesaid after August 15, 1940, except absentee voting; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio proposes to call a ~~General~~ *Special* Election to be held on the ~~6th~~ ^{2nd} day of ~~May~~ ^{Oct}, 1951 ~~and if required a Run Off Election on the 22nd day of May 1951~~, in the several election precincts within the corporate limits of the City San Antonio; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, on ~~April 2, 1951~~, passed an order authorizing and empowering the County Judge of Bexar County, Texas, to enter into a contract and agreement with the City of San Antonio to lease or rent to said City approximately ¹²⁵ ~~220~~ voting machines which said voting machines are now in the custody of Bexar County, Texas, for use by said City in said elections to be held on the ~~6th~~ ^{2nd} day of ~~May~~ ^{Oct} 1951 ~~and if needed the 22nd day of May 1951~~, the rent to be charged by Bexar County to be at the rate of \$20.00 per machine; that the City of San Antonio is to pay in addition to the above rental and for its own account, the cost of preparation of said machines for said elections and the cost of servicing said machines prior to and on the date of said elections, and for the City of San Antonio to further pay for the drayage of said machines from the Bexar County Court House to each of the several election places within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio and to pay for any drayage necessary for the return of said voting machines from said voting places either to the Bexar County Court House or to such places, within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, as may be designated by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas; NOW, THEREFORE:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Charles W. Anderson, the duly authorized, elected qualified and acting County Judge of Bexar County, Texas, pursuant to the aforesaid order, for and in consideration of the sum of rental, to be paid by the City of San Antonio to Bexar County, Texas, said sum to cover the rental charge for approximately ~~200~~¹²⁵ voting machines at the rate of \$20.00 per machine, do hereby rent to the City of San Antonio for the use of said City at its elections to be held on the ~~8th day~~^{2nd day of Oct} 1951 and if need^{ed}, on May 22nd 1951 approximately ~~200~~¹²⁵ voting machines.

It is further understood and agreed that the City of San Antonio is to pay all costs connected with the preparation of said machines for use in said elections above mentioned, and further that the City of San Antonio is to pay all costs in connection with the servicing of said machines prior to and on the day of said elections, and it is further understood and agreed that the City of San Antonio is to pay all drayage involved in the moving of said machines from the Court House of Bexar County, Texas, to the several voting places used by the City of San Antonio in the said elections and that the City of San Antonio is further to pay all costs of drayage involved in the return of said voting machines to the Bexar County Court House or to such place or places, within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, as may be designated by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas.


It is further agreed that the City of San Antonio shall cause to be prepared, at its own expense, all election ballots and supplies which may be necessary to conduct said elections and the City of San Antonio hereby agrees that it shall be liable for all damages to or destruction of any voting machines which shall occur from any cause whatsoever from the time said machines are turned over to the City of San Antonio by Bexar County, or its agent, until the time that said machines are returned to the custody of the County.

And it is hereby agreed and understood that for the purpose of enforcing this provision the machines shall be inspected jointly by an agent of the County and an agent of the City before they are placed in the custody of the City. And that any damages or defects then existing to any of said machines shall be recorded.



Upon the return of the machines, immediately after they are unloaded and before they are placed in storage, said machines shall be again inspected by an agent of the County and an agent of the City for the purpose of determining what damages, if any, have occurred during the period of custody by the City of San Antonio. The damages so determined by the agents of the County and the City shall be the basis of the City's liability, if any, under this provision of the contract.

The City of San Antonio hereby agrees that the rental charge hereinabove provided for is to be remitted to the County of Bexar on or before the 1st. day of ~~June~~ ^{Jan - 1952} 1951.


