

ORDINANCE CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS

THE STATE OF TEXAS :  
COUNTY OF BEXAR :  
CITY OF SAN ANTONIO :

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City duly ordered an election to be held in said City on the 3rd day of December, 1966, on the PROPOSITION hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding, and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the City Council officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered, that proper notice of said election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election, that said election was duly held, that due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law.

2. That the City Council officially finds and determines that only resident, qualified electors who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation were allowed to vote at said election, and that the following votes were cast at said election on the PROPOSITION submitted:

PROPOSITION

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TOWER BONDS" 25,112 Votes;

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF TOWER BONDS" 14,295 Votes.

3. That the City Council officially finds, determines and declares the result of said election to be that the PROPOSITION so submitted has received a favorable majority vote and has carried, and that all of said bonds may be issued in accordance with law.

4. That this Ordinance is hereby passed as an emergency measure, to be effective immediately upon enactment, such emergency being that the proceeds from the bonds voted on as herein provided are required as soon as possible for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, and safety.

That a true, full, and correct copy of the aforesaid Ordinance passed at the Meeting described in the above and foregoing paragraph is attached to and follows this Certificate; that said Ordinance has been duly recorded in said City Council's minutes of said Meeting; that the above and foregoing paragraph is a true, full, and correct excerpt from said City Council's minutes of said Meeting pertaining to the passage of said Ordinance; that the persons named in the above and foregoing paragraph are the duly chosen, qualified, and acting officers and members of said City Council as indicated therein; and that each of the officers and members of said City Council was duly and sufficiently notified officially and personally, in advance, of the time, place, and purpose of the aforesaid Meeting, and that said Ordinance would be introduced and considered for passage at said Meeting, and each of said officers and members consented, in advance, to the holding of said Meeting for such purpose.
