ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF TALLEY TRANSFER CO., FOR TRANSPORTATION OF VOTING MACHINES FOR CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD MAY 8, 1951, AND MAKING CONTRACT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,


1. That the proposal of Talley Transfer Company, dated April 4, 1951, attached hereto and made a part hereof, for transportation, setting up and connecting of voting machines for use in the City Election to be held on May 8th., 1951, from Bexar County Court House to the various polling places of said City and return to said Bexar County Court House within two (2) days after said election, at a price of \$6.38 for the round trip, be and the same is hereby accepted.

2. That this ordinance makes and manifests the contract between the City of San Antonio and said Talley Transfer Company, for said transportation of approximately 220 voting machines, each machine to be hauled from the basement of the Bexar County Court House to the various polling places throughout the City of San Antonio, set up and electrically connected and returned to the basement of the Bexar County Court House within two (2) day after said election is held, all as contained in said proposal of said Talley Transfer Company dated April 4, 1951, attached hereto and made a part hereof.





RE: VOTING MACHINE TRANSPORTATION AND INSTALLATION

IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUEST FOR BIDS AS ADVERTISED IN THE COMMERCIAL RECORDER, WE ARE SUBMITTING THE FOLLOWING FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF VOTING MACHINES TO THE PRECINCTS FROM THE COURTHOUSE AND RETURN FOR THE MAY 22, 1951 ELECTION. THIS FIGURE ALSO INCLUDES ANY MACHINES USED SHOULD A RUN OFF BE NECESSARY. WE WILL APPRECIATE YOUR GIVING IT YOUR MOST CAREFUL CONSIDERATION.

FOR TRANSPORTATION FROM COURTHOUSE TO PRECINCTS AND FROM PRECINCTS TO THE COURTHOUSE.....ROUND TRIP. . . . \$6.38

THE ABOVE FIGURE INCLUDES RAISING MACHINES, WIRING, PLUGGING IN, AND THE EMPLOYMENT OF AN ELECTRICIAN AS NEEDED, ALSO THE LOWERING AND DISMANTELING OF SAME.

WE ARE WELL EQUIPPED TO HANDLE THIS SERVICE AND OPERATE TRUCKS THAT ARE MANED BY DRIVERS THOROUGHLY FAMILIAR WITH CHECKING, LOADING, DELIVERY, AND HANDLING OF VOTING MACHINES. A COMPLETE RECORD WILL BE KEPT AS TO THE CONDITION OF EACH MACHINE WHEN IT IS LOADED FOR DELIVERY, AND AFTER IT IS RETURNED TO THE COURTHOUSE. THIS RECORD WILL BE AVAILABLE SHOULD IT EVERY BE NEEDED.

WE ALSO FURNISH VOTING MACHINE SKIDS, BLOCK AND TACKLES, HOISTING EQUIPMENT FOR LOWERING MACHINES TO BASEMENT OR RAISING TO SECOND FLOORS, ALL ELECTRICAL CORDS, PLUGS AND EXTENSIONS, AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS ESPECIALLY DESIGNED FOR THE PURPOSE.

REALIZING THAT YOUR TECHNICIANS HAVE VERY LITTLE TIME IN WHICH TO CLEAR THE MACHINES AFTER THE ELECTION, SHOULD A RUN OFF OCCUR, WE WILL ARRANGE TO HAVE THE MACHINES RETURNED TO THE BASEMENT OF THE COURTHOUSE IMMEDIATELY. WE WILL MAINTAIN A TRUCK AND CREW OF MEN TO REPLACE ANY MACHINES WHICH MIGHT GO OUT OF ORDER ON ELECTION DAY. THIS ARRANGEMENT WILL GIVE YOU SUFFICIENT TIME TO MAKE COMPLETE PREPARATION, AND RELIEVE YOU OF CONSIDERABLE STRAIN.

WE FEEL SURE THAT YOU WILL FIND THE ABOVE IN ORDER AND IF THERE IS ANY FURTHER INFORMATION NEEDED, PLEASE DO NOT HESITATE TO CALL ON US.
