The following petitions were read and referred to the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements:

Petition of Citizens that a certain Alley be named Potter street.

Petition to change the name of Presa street to Woodrow Way.

No. 299. **MC-708** AN ORDINANCE.

Appropriating \$2,064.12 to pay Colglazier Construction Company for maintainance of Roadways in Brackenridge Park.
