

A RESOLUTION **2011-02-17-0004R**

IN SUPPORT OF SUTTON OAKS II APARTMENTS FOR LOW INCOME HOUSING TAX CREDIT APPLICATION PROCESS AS REQUIRED BY THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS.

WHEREAS, the Sutton Oaks II Apartment Multi-family Housing Construction Project is a 208 unit Multi-family Development (the "Project"), proposed to be developed at approximately 750 Runnels Avenue between Locke Street and Hines Street in Council District 2; and

WHEREAS, ARDC Sutton II, Ltd. intends to submit an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) for 2011 Housing Tax Credits or Tax-Exempt Bonds, TDHCA HOME funds or Housing Trust Funds for Sutton Oaks II Apartments (the "Development"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 50.5(a)(8), Texas Administrative Code, we acknowledge that the proposed new construction development is located one (1) linear mile or less from a development that serves the same type of household as the new development and has received an allocation of Housing Tax Credits (including Tax-Exempt Bond Developments) for new construction since December 8, 2006; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 50.6 (g), Texas Administrative Code, we acknowledge that the proposed new construction development is located in a census tract that has more than thirty percent (30%) Housing Tax Credit units per total household in the census tract; and

WHEREAS, the proposed development is an additional phase to existing tax credit development, such as Sutton Oaks I, and the combined unit total for the existing and proposed development, once completed, will be four hundred and two (402) units, which exceeds the project size limitation of two hundred (200) low-income units unless supported by the local governing body by a resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Project will include dwelling units subsidized through the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs Housing Tax Credit Program, which will provide housing opportunities for families with a mixture of incomes; and

WHEREAS, the developer of the Project has prepared an application to the State of Texas for Low-Income Housing Tax Credits to receive assistance in financing the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas has a policy against funding low-income developments within one (1) linear mile or less of an existing development or developments that serve the same type of household unless allowed by vote of the local government; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Project has support from the District 2 City Council Representative; that the developer has contacted the Government Hill Neighborhood Association and other area residents and received no negative comment; and that there is a demand for the multi-family development in the proposed location; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio has determined there is a need for additional affordable housing units in the proposed development location and has reviewed a market study which supports this determination; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City of San Antonio hereby allows the development and construction of the Sutton Oaks II Apartments Multi-family Housing Construction Project.




