THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, ON  
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 8, 1959, AT 9:00 A.M.

The Clerk read the call of the meeting.

Mayor Kuykendall announced that the Council was in session to canvass the returns of the City General Election of April 7. He directed the City Clerk and tabulators to produce the returns for canvassing purposes.

The Council proceeded to check the return sheets and after all were checked the Mayor announced a recess until 2:00 p.m. to give the machine operators time to add all figures. During the process of checking, Mr. C. Ray Crites, and Mr. Parker Southern both candidates in the election filed requests that the voting machines be checked against the returns.

## AN ORDINANCE 27,472

DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO APPLY TO A DISTRICT JUDGE OF BEXAR COUNTY FOR AN ORDER TO BREAK THE SEALS OF VOTING MACHINES USED IN THE CITY ELECTION HELD ON APRIL 7, 1959, FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPARING THE VOTES ACTUALLY RECORDED ON SAID MACHINES AGAINST THE OFFICIAL RETURNS OF SAID ELECTION
