AN ORDINANCE *MI-827*

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ASSIGN TO B. F. DITTMAR COMPANY CERTAIN STREETSWIDENING BENEFIT ASSESSMENT CERTIFICATES FOR SOUTH ALAMO STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and empowered to execute an assignment of City of San Antonio Assignable Certificates of Special Assessment for street widening improvements on South Alamo Street between East Market Street and East Nueva Street, issued under "The Improvement Ordinance" and "The Special Assessment Ordinance for South Alamo Street"; said Certificates all bearing the date of May 14th, 1928, and being more particularly described by number, name and amount, as follows:-

3. Upon the delivery and acceptance of said Certificates, B. F. Dittmar Company shall pay the City of San Antonio therefor on the basis of Ninety-Eight (98¢) Cents flat on par, for full assessment covered by such certificates.

4. The City of San Antonio shall assign said certifiactes to B. F. Dittmar Company without recourse, but subject to all the rights and remedies under the laws of the State of Texas and the Ordinances of the City of San Antonio governing the assignment thereof.

AN ORDINANCE *MI-828*

GRANTING D. JOHNSON THE RIGHT OF INGRESS AND EGRESS INTO THE AUDITORIUM GROUNDS.

1. That the design of the elevations facing the Auditorium Grounds, and the amterial thereof, of the building for D. Johnson located on Lot 17, New City Block No. 412, according to plans dated 5/2/29, prepared by Adams and Adams, Architects, has been examined and found in accord with the type of buildings approved for lots facing the Auditorium.

2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a deed, granting D. Johnson, his heirs and assigns the right of ingress and egress to his property from the Auditorium Grounds of the City of San Antonio.
