

AN ORDINANCE

88771

APPOINTING JOE D. GONZALES AS A NEW PART-TIME MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE TO SERVE THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF OFFICE ENDING AUGUST 31, 1999, OF FORMER JUDGE JESSE SEPULVEDA, AS REQUESTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL'S MUNICIPAL COURT COMMITTEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE UPON PASSAGE BY EIGHT (8) AFFIRMATIVE VOTES.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court Committee of the City Council met on October 15 & 22, 1998, to review applications for those individuals seeking appointments and to interview candidates for the part-time Municipal Court Judge position presently vacant due to the resignation of former Judge Jesse Sepulveda; and

WHEREAS, the Committee, after careful review of all applications, selected five (5) applicants for interviews which were held on October 22, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the consensus of the Committee recommends the appointment of Joe D. Gonzales to fill such vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to appoint Joe D. Gonzales as a part-time Municipal Court Judge to serve the unexpired term of former Judge Jesse Sepulveda; and

WHEREAS, the importance of this issue requires that City Council action to appoint judges take effect immediately in order to maintain public confidence in the Municipal Court and in order to preserve and protect public health, safety, and welfare through efficient enforcement of laws within the jurisdiction of the Municipal Court; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Joe D. Gonzales is hereby appointed as a new part-time judge of Municipal Court to serve the unexpired term of former part-time Municipal Court Judge Jesse Sepulveda. This appointment is for the remaining unexpired term of former Judge Jesse Sepulveda to expire on August 31, 1999.

SECTION 2. Mr. Gonzales shall be paid at the same rate as other part-time Municipal Court Judges as heretofore set by the City Council.

SECTION 3. Because the importance of this issue requires that City Council action to appoint judges take effect immediately in order to maintain public confidence in the Municipal Court and in order to preserve and protect public health, safety, and welfare through efficient enforcement of laws within the jurisdiction of the Municipal Court, an emergency is declared so that upon receipt of eight affirmative votes, this ordinance shall be effective immediately; otherwise, this ordinance shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.
