BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the Mayor is authorized to exchange four (4) certain tracts of land lying at and west of Powell Street Extension, between it and the east line of the Union Meat Company, and also the east line of City Block 6187 and the new west line of the San Pedro Creek, and a part of Ralph Street lying east of the new established line of the San Pedro Ditch, and a track of land out of Ralph Street west of the new established line of the San Pedro Ditch, for four (4) tracts of land, one out of Lot A-6, in City Block A-18, one tract out of City Block 3127, and two (2) tracts out of Lot A-6, City Block A-18, and an easement across the land of the Union Meat Company.

SECTION TWO: So much of Ralph Street west of the tracts herein conveyed to the Union Meat Company is hereby ordered closed, and the connection with Powell Street across the San Pedro Creek and the new bridge is hereby ordered to be recorded in the City Engineer's Office.

SECTION THREE: Upon the execution of the deed of exchange and its approval by the City Attorney, the same is hereby ordered accepted, and to be put of record.

Cancelling a contract between the City of San Antonio and Southwest Bitulithic Company for

the improvement of Iowa Street from Cherry Street to Hackberry Street, and repealing, rescinding and annulling a certain ordinance levying special assessments for the cost of such improvements which ordinance was passed and approved by the Commissioners of said City on August 17th, 1922.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WHEREAS, the Commissioners heretofore, to-wit, on July 7th, 1922, entered into a written contract with the Southwest Bitulithic Company for the improvement of Iowa Street from Cherry Street to Hackberry Street, by paving the same with Warrenite-Bitulithic paving and in connection with said contract the Southwest Bitulithic Company executed and delivered to the City certain bonds, one designated construction bond, being for the sum of \$3500.00 and the other designated maintenance bond in the sum of \$1800.00, both of which bonds are of even date with said contract; and,

WHEREAS, thereafter, to-wit, on the 17th day of August, 1922, the Commissioners of said City of San Antonio duly passed an ordinance levying special assessments for the cost of said improvements on Iowa Street, from Cherry Street to Hackberry Street, and providing for the issuance of assessment certificates and for other purposes, which ordinance is of record in Street Improvement Records of the City, Volume 11, pages 107 to 114 inclusive, and,

WHEREAS, the Southwest Bitulithic Company has in writing, signified its willingness to have said contract for the improvement of said street between said intersections canceled and annulled and to have the said ordinance levying said assessments against the owners of property on said street, repealed, rescinded and annulled.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED:

Section 1. That the contract entered into by and between the City of San Antonio and the Southwest Bitulithic Company, dated July 7th, 1922 for the performance by Southwest Bitulithic Company of the work of improving Iowa Street, from Cherry Street to Hackberry Street, by paving the same be, and the same is hereby canceled, annulled and held for naught, and said Southwest Bitulithic Company is hereby released and relieved from any responsibility or liability by reason of the execution and delivery to the city of said two bonds of even date with said contract, one being for \$3500.00 and designated construction bond and the other being for \$1800.00 and designated maintenance bond, and each of said bonds being signed by the United States Fidelity & Guaranty Company as surety for Southwest Bitulithic Company, principal in said bonds.

Section 2. That the ordinance levying special assessments for the cost of improvements on Iowa Street from Cherry Street to Hackberry Street passed and adopted by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio on the 17th day of August, 1922, and recorded in Street Improvement Records of said City, Volume 11, pages 107 to 114 inclusive, be and the same is hereby in all respects repealed, rescinded, annulled and held for naught, and that the assessments therein made against the owners of abutting property and against such abutting property be canceled, released and freed from any claim or lien heretofore existing by virtue of said assessment ordinance.

DIRECTING THE CONDEMNATION OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR UNDERGROUND STORM SEWER, OR DRAIN, THROUGH CERTAIN PROPERTY THEREIN DESCRIBED, OWNED OR CLAIMED BY LEO JACOBS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That there is a necessity for the appropriation and acquisition by the City of San Antonio of a right-of-way ten (10) feet in width, being five (5) feet on each side of a center line, for an underground storm sewer or drain across a certain tract or parcel of land described as Lot No. 16, New City Block No. 3840, situated within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, the said center line of which ten-foot right-of-way so desired by said city is described as follows, to-wit;

Beginning at a point in the north line of Conrad Street and south boundary of Lot No. 16, in New City Block No. 3840, 32.5 feet westerly from the southeast corner of said Lot No. 16,

Thence in a straight line 74.0 feet, more or less, to a point in the dividing line between Lot No. 16 and Lot No. 17, 69.0 feet northerly from the said southeast corner of Lot No. 16.

said right-of-way being needed by said city for the purposes of constructing, and the maintenance thereof, of an underground storm sewer, or drain; said sewer to have an average depth, across said property, as follows, to-wit; An average depth from the surface to the top of said sewer of 2.2 feet, and an average depth from the surface to the bottom of said sewer of 7.8 feet; said city to acquire only an Easement to said ten-foot strip for the purpose of constructing, and the maintenance thereof, of said sewer, or drain, with the right of ingress and egress on, through, over and across said ten-foot strip, at all times for said purposes; the owner of said land to have the free use of the surface of said land so long as the user thereof over and upon the line of said sewer, or drain, does not impair the user of said sewer, or drain, or the maintenance thereof, by said city.

SECTION TWO: That said property is owned or claimed by Leo Jacobs, a resident citizen of Bexar County, Texas.

SECTION THREE: That said Leo Jacobs and the said city have failed to and cannot agree on the value of said right-of-way or the damage by reason of the appropriation and taking thereof

by the said city; therefore, the same is ordered condemned and the City Attorney is, at once, directed to begin and prosecute the necessary proceedings therefor.

SECTION FOUR: A plat of said property is ordered filed with the City Clerk as provided by the Charter of said city.

The hearing of property owners interested in the improvement of Mistletoe Avenue from Ripley St. to Aganier Avenue, continued from January 19, was again postponed until February, 2, 1925.
