CANVASS OF VOTE

The Clerk read the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE 66,030

CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF
THE BOND ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 1987.

City Clerk Norma S. Rodriguez briefly explained the canvassing procedures required by law and any special announcements concerning the canvass.

At this point the members of the City Council canvassed the vote of the November 3, 1987 city bond election by Council district.

Afterwhich, Mr. Hasslochler made a motion to approve the proposed Ordinance. Ms. Vera seconded the motion.

Mayor Cisneros thanked the City Council for their hard work in assuring passage of this bond issue, being the largest in the city's history. Mayor Cisneros stated that to him this shows the maturity of San Antonio citizens towards the importance of streets and drainage. He then spoke to several prominent instances of completed city bond projects in all sectors of the city including his contention that the public is confident about its city government. He noted further that the bonds passed with a plurality of some 67% of the voters in favor of the bond.

After consideration, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Ordinance, prevailed by the following vote: AYES: Berriozabal, Webb, Dutmer, Wing, Martinez, Thompson, Vera, Labatt, Hasslochler, Cisneros; NAYS: None; ABSENT: Wolff.

There being no further business to come before the City Council
the meeting was adjourned at 5:25 P.M.
