Stephens to re-imburse him for such expenditures.

AN ORDINANCE *-196*

Appropriating the sum of \$2054.25 to pay I.N. Stephens for expenses incurred in opening Cameron Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Two Thousand and Fifty Four dollars and twenty five cents (\$2054.25) be and is hereby appropriated out of the Opening, Widening and Straightening Streets Fund Bond Issue September 1, 1919, to pay I.N. Stephens for amount expenses in construction of retaining wall and right of way along the banks of the San Pedro Creek through N.C.B. 202, and that a warrant be drawn for said amount in favor of I.N. Stephens to reimburse him for such expenditures.
