ACCEPTING THE BID OF TARRILLION BROS. FOR PLUMBING FOR FIRE STATION 2 AND REPAIR SHOP - JOB 440: AND APPROPRIATING \$4491.00 TO PAY COSTS AND EXPENSES OF SUCH INSTALLATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the City of San Antonio does hereby accept the bid of Tarrillion Bros., of 223 Barrera Street, San Antonio, Texas, for Plumbing, Sewers, Water and Gas Piping, complete, as shown on Mechanical Plans and Specifications 440 for Fire Station No. 2 and Repair Shop, bid dated February 17, 1938, provided said party making said proposal shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of this ordinance and all instructions herein referred to, which are made a part hereof.

2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to require and approve on behalf of the City proper bond for the performance and completing of said undertaking.

3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to cause and require the execution and delivery of a written contract to be drawn in accordance with said proposal, and the terms and conditions understood and required as applicable to said matter.

4. That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises, \$4491.00, or as much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is appropriated hereby out of the A - Fire Station 2 Building Fund of 1937.
