

AN ORDINANCE 2007 - 03 - 29 - 0357

AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF \$49,500 TO AUSTIN-SAN ANTONIO INTERMUNICIPAL COMMUTER RAIL DISTRICT FOR THE CITY'S ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP DUES FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2006 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2007.

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WHEREAS, the Austin-San Antonio Intermunicipal Commuter Rail District was authorized by the 77th Texas State Legislature and is comprised of four (4) local governments – Austin and Travis County, San Antonio and Bexar County; and

WHEREAS, the Austin-San Antonio Intermunicipal Commuter Rail District was established to respond to increased traffic volumes on the IH-35 corridor and to offer mobility solutions; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the District is to facilitate the creation of a regional passenger rail system that will help reduce congestion, lower traffic fatalities, improve mobility, promote economic development and accelerate commerce along the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Rail District's activities are one part of a three step strategy to reduce congestion on IH-35 by improving mobility and commerce along the Austin-San Antonio corridor: the first step is to support efforts to construct SH-130; the second step is to support ongoing negotiations between Texas Department of Transportation and Union Pacific Rail Road to re-route through freight away from the corridor; and finally the third, to develop a commuter passenger rail system; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes payment of the City of San Antonio's annual membership dues to the Austin-San Antonio Intermunicipal Commuter Rail District in the amount of \$49,500.00, for the period commencing October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007; and

WHEREAS, approval of this Ordinance is a continuation of City Council policy to cooperate in identifying and supporting the implementation of transportation mobility solutions for the San Antonio Metropolitan Area; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$49,500.00 for the City of San Antonio's annual membership dues to the Austin-San Antonio Intermunicipal Commuter Rail District for the period commencing October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007 is hereby authorized.

SECTION 2. The following financial adjustments are hereby authorized to effect this Ordinance:

- a) Funding for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000 General Fund, Cost Center 80024300011 CITY WIDE ORGANIZATIONAL MEMBERSHIP, General ledger 5203050 Membership Dues and Licenses.
- b) Payment in the amount of \$70,000.00 is authorized to SAMCo and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective on the 8th day of April, 2007.


